## NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL

MEMORANDUM FOR ROBERT C. McFARLANE

FROM: GASTON J. SIGUR *Gastur*

SUBJECT: Visit of Korean Ambassador, Byong Hion Lew,  
Saturday, November 5 at 11:00 a.m.

The Korean Ambassador is coming by to see you tomorrow at 11:00 a.m. This is basically a courtesy call. He wants to shake your hand before he leaves for Seoul on Monday, November 7, to be there to consult with President Chun prior to the President's visit late next week.

While you have only five minutes with him, you should take the occasion to tell him that you are looking forward to accompanying the President to Korea and to discussions with President Chun. You should express to him our anger at the confirmed North Korean planned and implemented terrorist attack in Rangoon, and give high praise to President Chun and his government for their handling of the situation. You should say that the U.S. will be in continuing and close consultation with the ROKG about steps to be taken to deal appropriately with this horrible incident which is an affront to the entire civilized world.
