REQUEST: Private Meeting with Korean Foreign Minister
Lee Won Kyung

PURPOSE: Minister Lee has asked to pay a courtesy
call on the President

BACKGROUND: A meeting with Foreign Minister Lee would
signal continuing high-level American interest
in Korea. This would be particularly appro-
priate in view of the enormous success of the
President's recent visit.

PREVIOUS PARTICIPATION: None. Lee is the successor of Bum Suk Lee,
who died last month in the Rangoon tragedy,
and whom the President had met.

DATE AND TIME: November 29, 30 or December 1 for 15 minutes.
