On October 9, 1983, terrorists from North Korea planted bombs that killed 20 and wounded 47 people at the Martyrs' Mausoleum in Rangoon, Burma. The government of Burma has officially accused North Korea of masterminding the temple bombing, after completing a thorough investigation of the cold-blooded terrorism. The government of Burma has already expelled all the diplomats of North Korea, and has broken diplomatic relations with North Korea for this crime. We urge the rest of the world to do the same.

The one hundred-fifty thousand members of the Korean Association of New York condemn the Burma bombing and protest this barbaric action of international terrorism. We shall not tolerate these atrocious crimes. Stronger steps should be taken to reduce the likelihood of any repetition of international terrorism.

We strongly urge all the people of the free world to join with us to protect our freedom and to maintain peace in the world. We would like to express our deep appreciation of your continued strong policy for international security.
