I. PURPOSE

To gain Mrs. Massie's latest impressions of the Soviet scene.

II. BACKGROUND

Mrs. Massie's substantial experience and expertise make her a source of special insights into Soviet affairs. An established and successful writer on Russian history, culture, and traditions, she has developed a wide range of connections across the spectrum of Soviet society, particularly among artists and intellectuals. She has just completed her fourth extended visit to the USSR in the space of little over a year and is looking forward to discussing her impressions of the current situation in Moscow. She has met the Gorbachevs on several occasions and may have personal comments from them. She will undoubtedly have interesting observations about the upcoming celebration of the Millenium of Christianity in Kiev Rus' and how the Soviets plan to observe it.
