COAST GUARD ISSUES

I. BACKGROUND

- Coast Guard delegation visited Moscow April 7-8 for talks on a Search and Rescue (SAR) agreement. Talks went well, Soviets examining U.S. proposed draft agreement. Soviets still need to ratify 1979 International SAR Convention, say they will do so by end of this year.
- Coast Guard hosted talks on a Radionavigation Agreement in Washington August 18-20. Talks went well, both sides examining each other's presentation. Next steps will be decided following that examination.


II. SOVIET VIEWS AND OBJECTIVES
