

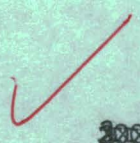

SUBJECT: VALIDATING SENIOR OFFICER FUNCTIONAL SKILL CODES

REF: STATE 161754, JUNE 10, 1983

1. WE ARE NOT CERTAIN YOU RECEIVED SUBJECT MEMO IN WASHINGTON AT THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL. WE SEND IT FOR YOUR INFORMATION AND BECAUSE A REPLY IS DUE ON JULY 1.

2. THE 1983 SELECTION BOARD PRECEPTS, ON WHICH THE DEPARTMENT AND AFSA HAVE RECENTLY REACHED AGREEMENT, INCLUDE NEW PROVISIONS AFFECTING CONSIDERATION OF OFFICERS FOR PROMOTION IN CLASS FEOC, AND FOR LIMITED CAREER EXTENSION (LCE) IN CLASSES FEOC AND FEMC. IMPORTANTLY, THE PROVISIONS CALL FOR PROMOTION AND EXTENSION COMPETITION OF GENERALIST OFFICERS BOTH CLASSWIDE AND IN THEIR PRINCIPAL FUNCTIONAL CONE. AS THESE NEW PROVISIONS AFFECT YOUR REVIEW BY THE 1983 BOARDS, THIS CABLE IS BEING SENT TO YOU TO EXPLAIN THE PROCEDURES, TO ADVISE YOU OF THE FUNCTIONAL CATEGORY IN WHICH YOU WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR PROMOTION AND/OR EXTENSION, AND TO PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR YOU TO APPEAL THAT FUNCTIONAL DESIGNATION, IF YOU BELIEVE THAT IT IS ERRONEOUS AND YOU QUALIFY FOR CONSIDERATION IN ANOTHER AREA AS DESCRIBED BELOW.

3. THE 1983 PRECEPTS PROVIDE THAT FOREIGN SERVICE GENERALISTS (OFFICERS WITH PRIMARY EXECUTIVE, PROGRAM DIRECTION, ADMINISTRATIVE, CONSULAR, ECONOMIC OR POLITICAL SKILL CODES) IN CLASS FEOC WILL BE CONSIDERED AND RANK ORDERED FOR PROMOTION TWICE--IN CLASSWIDE COMPETITION ON THE BASIS OF RELATIVE INTERFUNCTIONAL STRENGTHS AS IN PAST YEARS, AND BY CONE, ON THE BASIS OF FUNCTIONAL SKILLS. THE PRECEPTS ALSO PROVIDE THAT GENERALISTS IN CLASS FEOC AND FEMC WHO ARE IN THEIR LAST YEAR OF TIME-IN-CLASS (TIC) AND WHO ARE TO BE REVIEWED FOR EXTENSION IF NOT PROMOTED, WILL BE CONSIDERED AND RANK ORDERED FOR LCE'S BOTH IN CLASSWIDE COMPETITION AND BY FUNCTIONAL CONE UNDER CRITERIA SIMILAR TO PROMOTION CRITERIA.

4. THE NUMBER OF PROMOTION OPPORTUNITIES FROM CLASS FEOC TO FEMC AND THE NUMBER OF LCE OPPORTUNITIES IN BOTH CLASSES WILL BE DETERMINED AND ALLOCATED BASED ON INTERFUNCTIONAL AND FUNCTIONAL NEEDS. PROMOTIONS AND EXTENSIONS IN EACH CATEGORY WILL BE GRANTED, UP TO THE NUMBER OF OPPORTUNITIES AUTHORIZED FOR THAT CATEGORY, IN RANK ORDER TO THE HIGHEST RANKING OFFICERS IN THE CATEGORY.

5. DUAL CONSIDERATION FOR PROMOTION AND EXTENSION IN CLASS FEOC AND FOR EXTENSION IN CLASS FEMC IS A MORE SENSITIVE AND EQUITABLE WAY, THAN CLASSWIDE COMPETITION ALONE, OF IDENTIFYING NEEDS AND OF DETERMINING WHICH OFFICERS ARE MOST QUALIFIED TO FILL AVAILABLE PROMOTION AND EXTENSION OPPORTUNITIES. SENIOR LEVEL POSITIONS MAY REQUIRE BROAD EXECUTIVE SKILLS WHICH SPAN FUNCTIONAL LINES OR CALL FOR IN-DEPTH EXPERTISE PRIMARILY IN A SINGLE CONE. DUAL COMPETITION ALLOWS THESE DIFFERENT OPPORTUNITIES TO BE ALLOCATED TO THE OFFICERS MOST QUALIFIED TO FILL THEM AND PERMITS ALL OFFICERS TO COMPETE MOST EFFECTIVELY ON THE BASIS OF THEIR PARTICULAR CAREER STRENGTHS.
