Dear Mr. Chairman:

In accordance with the request contained in the Joint Explanatory Statement of the State Department Authorization Bill Conference Committee (pages H.10258-9 of the Congressional Record, No. 160, Part II, November 17, 1983), I am forwarding to you the attached State Department Report on "Applying the Principles of Equivalence and Reciprocity to the Soviet and Soviet Bloc Representation in the United States."

In composing this report, the Department has sought to fulfill to the maximum extent possible the Conference Committee's request. Specifically, the report analyzes the functioning and operations of official representatives of Soviet and Soviet Bloc countries in the United States, and official representatives of the United States in Soviet and Soviet Bloc countries with regard to their numbers, status, privileges and immunities, travel, accomodations and facilities. The report reviews legal and administrative measures that have been or might be taken to implement the principles of reciprocity and equivalence and to reduce the harm to national security caused by the presence in the United States of Soviet and Soviet Bloc intelligence personnel acting as official representatives of their countries, while taking into account the foreign policy, foreign intelligence collection and national security interests which bear on this subject. As requested by the Conference Committee, the report has been classified to the extent necessary, and it includes the views of all relevant departments and agencies of the executive branch.
