SUBJECT:

Secret Service Protection for Soviet Foreign Minister Eduard Shevardnadze

The Soviets have requested Secret Service protection for Foreign Minister Eduard Shevardnadze during his forthcoming visit to the United States. He plans to arrive in New York on October 23rd and will depart on October 27th. Details of his schedule are still tentative, but we understand that he will remain in New York the entire time he is in the United States.

Foreign Minister Shevardnadze will attend the 40th Anniversary of the United Nations General Assembly and will meet with Secretary Shultz in an important preliminary to the Geneva meeting between President Reagan and Soviet General Secretary Gorbachev. We anticipate that there will be a great deal of media interest in his visit, particularly in light of the Geneva meeting. Foreign Minister Shevardnadze, like his predecessor Mr. Gromyko, received Secret Service protection during his past visit. The Secret Service has informally told us on a working level that they are willing to provide protection for him.

In light of the importance of the trip, the high profile of the visit and the precedent of earlier USSS protection, we believe that Secret Service protection is warranted for this trip. We ask that you convey our request for this coverage to the appropriate officials.

MEMORANDUM FOR MR. ROBERT C. MCFARLANE THE WHITE HOUSE

SUBJECT: Transportation Assistance for Soviet Foreign Minister Shevardnadze

Soviet Foreign Minister Shevardnadze will arrive in New York at 7:30 PM on October 23, to attend the Fortieth Anniversary Ceremonies at the United Nations. Shevardnadze has accepted the President's invitation to the reception being given that evening at the UN for foreign dignitaries.

The Soviets have pointed out that in view of his late arrival, it will be difficult for Shevardnadze to make the reception. They have indicated that Shevardnadze would be prepared to fly from John F. Kennedy Airport to the UN by helicopter to meet with the President, if the U.S. could provide the means.

The Department believes that a meeting between the President and Shevardnadze would be in our interests. Accordingly, we request that the NSC authorize helicopter transportation for Shevardnadze from John F. Kennedy Airport to the UN. Shevardnadze would be accompanied by his wife, an interpreter and perhaps one additional escort.
