SUBJECT: Draft JCC Issues and Objectives

Plans are moving ahead for the March Joint US-USSR Commercial Commission (JCC) meeting in Moscow. A Soviet Working Group, headed at the Assistant Secretary level, is expected to arrive in Washington February 18 to meet with U.S. counterparts regarding the agenda and goals for the JCC meeting. U.S. goals and positions need to be determined in advance of that time.

As was promised at the preliminary JCC planning meeting chaired by Dr. Lotarski on January 22, we have prepared a draft Issues and Objectives paper that lays out the proposed scope, objectives, and policy guidance for the JCC meeting. This paper reflects all ideas received at, and subsequent to, the January 22 meeting.

Your clearance or comments would be appreciated by noon Tuesday, February 9. A revised paper will be distributed Wednesday, and an Assistant Secretary level meeting of the JCC agencies is being planned for 4:00 p.m. Thursday, February 11. Assistant Secretary Laun will chair the meeting, which will be for the purpose of:

- (1) Discussing the objectives and plans for the JCC prior to making recommendations to Secretary Verity;
- (2) Discussing strategy for the Working Group meeting with Soviet officials tentatively planned for February 18-22.

Assistant Secretary Laun's office will call the appropriate officials directly regarding the Thursday meeting.
