STATEMENT FOR USE BY LARRY SPEAKES

The President has warmly welcomed Father Jenco after his long and cruel ordeal. The President noted that the happiness of this occasion is tempered by the fact that other Americans and innocents of several nationalities remain captive in Lebanon. Father Jenco was serving in Lebanon in an effort to help the people of that strife-torn country. He and the other American hostages, had dedicated to themselves to service for their fellow man.

The warm welcome that Father Jenco has received this week from the Pope, the Archbishop of Canterbury, and his friends, family, and nation serves as a tribute to a brave man and his faith. The President again expressed his thanks for the work of all those of many different nationalities and organizations who continue to work for the safe return of all hostages.

Those who held Father Jenco in cruel and uncertain confinement must realize that their objectives cannot be achieved by these means. They bring no sympathy or honor to themselves or the cause they profess to support. It is time for the captors and those with influence over them to end this prolonged situation in the name of peace and justice. We continue to hold the captors and those who support them responsible for the safety of the remaining hostages.

1. COVERAGE IN THE ARABIC LANGUAGE PRESS TO JENCO'S MEETINGS WITH THE POPE AND THE ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY WAS GENERALLY STRAIGHTFORWARD AND LOW KEY. MOST PAPERS GAVE THE MEETINGS FRONT-PAGE COVERAGE, OR ELSE COVERED THEM ON INSIDE PAGES THAT NORMALLY CONTAIN WORLD NEWS TOPICS. ALLHAPERS CHECKED STATED THAT WAITE HAD EXPRESSED HIS WILLINGNESS TO MEET THE KIDNAPPERS AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE TIME. SEVERAL PAPERS MENTIONED THE LETTER THAT THE POPE HAD GIVEN TO JENCO, IN WHICH THE PONTIFF WAS QUOTED AS HOPING FOR A QUICK MEETING BETWEEN THE KIDNAPPERS AND WAITE, AND A SPEEDY RESOLUTION TO THE PROBLEM. WAITE WAS QUOTED IN SOME OF THE REPORTS AS SAYING THAT A SOLUTION IS POSSIBLE BASED ON "MUTUQ RELIGIOUS TRADITIONS".

WAITE GENERALLY DECLINED COMMENT ON WHAT, IF ANY, ROLE HE PLAYED IN ARRANGING JENCO'S RELEASE. MCNAMARA

AFTER FATHER JENCO VISITED THE WHITE HOUSE SAID WE
CONTINUE TO HOLD THE CAPTORS AND THOSE WHO SUPPORT THEM

Q: WHAT ARE YOU DOING TO SECURE THE RELEASE OF THE HOSTAGES?
A: AS THE PRESIDENT HAS SAID BEFORE, WE JUST CANNOT GET
INTO THE DETAILS BEYOND THE FACT THAT A VARIETY OF

PERSONS AND INTERMEDIARIES, LIKE TERRY WAITE, HAVE BEEN HELPFUL IN THE PAST AND CONTINUE THEIR EFFORTS.

Q: WILL THE U.S. NEGOTIATE FOR THE RELEASE OF THE REMAINING HOSTAGES AS PEGGY SAY AND DAVID JACOBSEN HAVE SUGGESTED?

A: I WILL REITERATE THAT WE HAVE CONSISTENTLY SAID IN THE PAST, THAT WE ARE ALWAYS WILLING TO TALK TO ANYONE, ANYWHERE ABOUT THE SAFE RETURN OF THE HOSTAGES. WE WILL NOT PAY RANSOMS, GRANT CONCESSIONS, OR OTHERWISE CHANGE OUR POLICIES TO MEET TERRORISTS' DEMANDS.

Q: WILL THE USG ASK THE KUWAITI GOVERNMENT TO RELEASE THE 17 DAWA PRISONERS?

A: NO.

Q: HAS JENCO PROVIDED ANY INFORMATION THAT COULD LEAD TO THE RELEASE OF THE REMAINING HOSTAGES

A: FATHER JENCO IS THANKFUL FOR HIS RELEASE AND FREEDOM. HE HAS CONVEYED PRIVATE MESSAGES TO WORLD LEADERS AS HE HAS INSTRUCTED. BEYOND THAT HE IS ANXIOUS TO REST AND RECOVER FROM HIS LONG ORDEAL. HIS PRIMARY CONCERN IS THE SAFE RETURN OF THE REMAINING HOSTAGES AND NOTHING MORE.

Q: WHY HAS THERE BEEN NO MENTION OF WILLIAM BUCKLEY; IS HE DEAD?

A: WE HAVE NO INFORMATION THAT CAN CONFIRM HIS DEATH. UNTIL WE DO, WE WILL CONTINUE TO PRAY FOR HIS SAFE RETURN ALONG WITH TERRY ANDERSON, DAVID JACOBSEN AND THOMAS SUTHERLAND.






