SUBJECT: Proposed VP Trip to Ft. Bragg

Your staff asked us to look into a possible Vice Presidential visit to the CTJTF Headquarters late this month or early November which would include open press coverage.

Our coordination for the visit has surfaced a problem relating to current JCS OPSEC policy which limits access of any information about the CTJTF to only those individuals with a strict need-to-know (the fact that the CTJTF Headquarter's location is Ft. Bragg remains classified SECRET).

Current OPSEC policy for the CTJTF is one of the issues now before the Senior Review Group (Issue No. 17); wherein a modified, less stringent OPSEC policy is being recommended. Until such time as this issue is resolved, I believe the Vice President would be in a position of appearing to push the system more than current policy would permit.

Therefore, I would recommend that the trip be postponed pending the outcome of the issue. The Vice President could, however, conduct the visit supported by in-house photo coverage only. Another possibility would be a visit with the FBI's Hostage Rescue Team in Quantico, Virginia which is an unclassified organization modeled closely after the German's G5/G9 counter-terrorist team.
