COVERAGE STRESSED THAT EGYPT REJECTS "ALL ACTS OF TERRORISM REGARDLESS OF THEIR SOURCE OR MOTIVES OR PERPETRATORS." ABDEL MEGUID ALSO CALLS FOR INTENSIFIED EFFORTS TO SOLVE THE MIDDLE EAST PROBLEM AND BREAK THE VICIOUS CIRCLE OF VIOLENCE AND TERRORISM.
