## I. PURPOSE

This is a regularly scheduled meeting of the Cabinet.

## II. BACKGROUND

The only issue being discussed is the Strategic Petroleum Reserve. A working group has been developing a policy statement and a financing strategy for Presidential review.

The issue that needs to be decided is whether or not the Administration is willing to consider "off-budget" funding alternatives for the SPR proposed by Congress.

In the President's Economic Recovery Program, the Administration assumed on-budget funding of the SPR at a level of \$3.8 billion dollars. Congress is considering spending alternatives that involve off-budget funding.

The working group on the strategic petroleum reserve has identified several specific issues which will be discussed at the meeting. Dave Stockman will attempt to focus the question more narrowly on the off-budget issue mentioned above. OMB has provided a statement which will be added to the package of background materials prior to the meeting.
