SEQUENCE OF EVENTS

Official Luncheon for President Lopez-Portillo

June 9, 1981 - 12:30 p.m.

FROM: Muffie Brandon

12:00 p.m. Luncheon guests begin to arrive for the 12:30 p.m. luncheon. They arrive in the Dip Room and, when enough guests have gathered, are led up the Grand Staircase to the State Floor. They will be announced by a Social Aide as they come out of the Dip Room for the Press, and they will be announced as they are escorted into the State Dining Room.

(Harpist in the Dip Room; U. S. Marine Band Orchestra in the Main Foyer)

12:00 p.m. PRESIDENT REAGAN and President Lopez-Portillo depart from the West Wing and proceed to the Residence via the Colonnade. Three members of the Official Party will be with them, and they will be met by a Social Aide in the Cross Hall and escorted to join the rest of the Official Party.

PRESIDENT REAGAN proceeds to the Residence, and President Lopez-Portillo is escorted into the Lincoln Bedroom.

12:05 p.m. The Official Party arrives the Dip Room and use this time to freshen up in the rest rooms on the Ground Floor. They then are escorted up the Grand Staircase to the State Floor and into the Red Room. After enough guests have gathered in the State Dining Room, the Official Party is then announced into the State Dining Room (about 12:20 p.m.)

- 12:25 p.m. Guests arriving after 12:25 p.m. must be escorted up the back stairs and into the State Dining Room.
- PRESIDENT AND MRS. REAGAN join President Lopez-Portillo in the Yellow Oval Room.
- Guests are led from the State Dining Room to the Red Room where a receiving line is created by the Office of Protocol.
- 12:30 p.m. PRESIDENT AND MRS. REAGAN and President Lopez-Portillo enter the State Floor via the Grand Staircase, preceded by a Color Team which divides at the foot of the stairs. (Photo opportunity) THE PRINCIPALS then proceed to the Cross Hall and take their places in front of the Blue Room for the receiving line. (Honors are played). From West to East, the order is PRESIDENT REAGAN, President Lopez-Portillo, Mrs. Reagan.
- The Official Parties will precede other guests from the Red Room through the Receiving Line and directly into luncheon in the East Room. (The Chief of Protocol will stand directly to THE PRESIDENT'S left to make introductions in the Receiving Line.)
- At the termination of the Receiving Line, PRINCIPALS hold until all guests are in the East Room, then proceed down the Cross Hall and into the East Room.
- 12:45 p.m. Luncheon is served in the East Room.
- 1:30 p.m. Dessert is served, accompanied by Strolling Strings. Coffee is also then served at tables.
- 1:45 p.m. Toasts:
- THE PRESIDENT
- President Lopez-Portillo
- NOTE: Both toasts will be interpreted.
- 2:00 p.m. PRESIDENT REAGAN and MRS. REAGAN escort President Lopez-Portillo to the Blue Room, then MRS. REAGAN departs for the Residence.

2:00 p.m.

(continued) The Mexican Official Party then proceeds to the North Portico for a motorcade boarding. The U.S. Official Party and guests begin to proceed to the Diplomatic Reception Room and depart. Remaining guests may be served coffee in the Main Foyer.

2:05 p.m.

PRESIDENT REAGAN escorts President Lopez-Portillo from the Blue Room to the North Portico and makes farewell remarks. President Lopez-Portillo makes farewell remarks.

NOTE: Both remarks will be interpreted.

2:15 p.m.

President Lopez-Portillo departs the White House. PRESIDENT REAGAN proceeds to the Residence.

Remaining guests depart.
