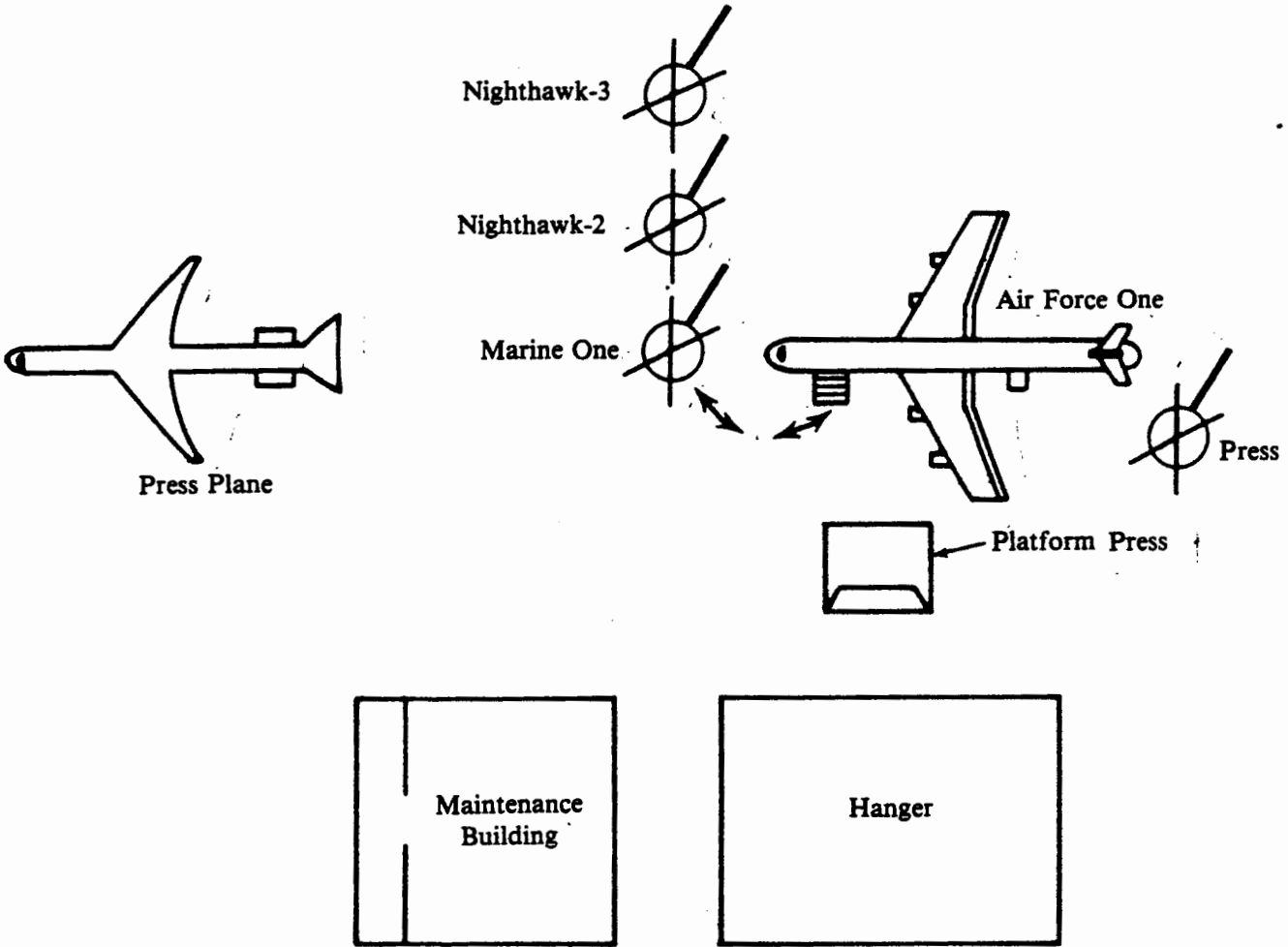

Arrival/Departure Diagram



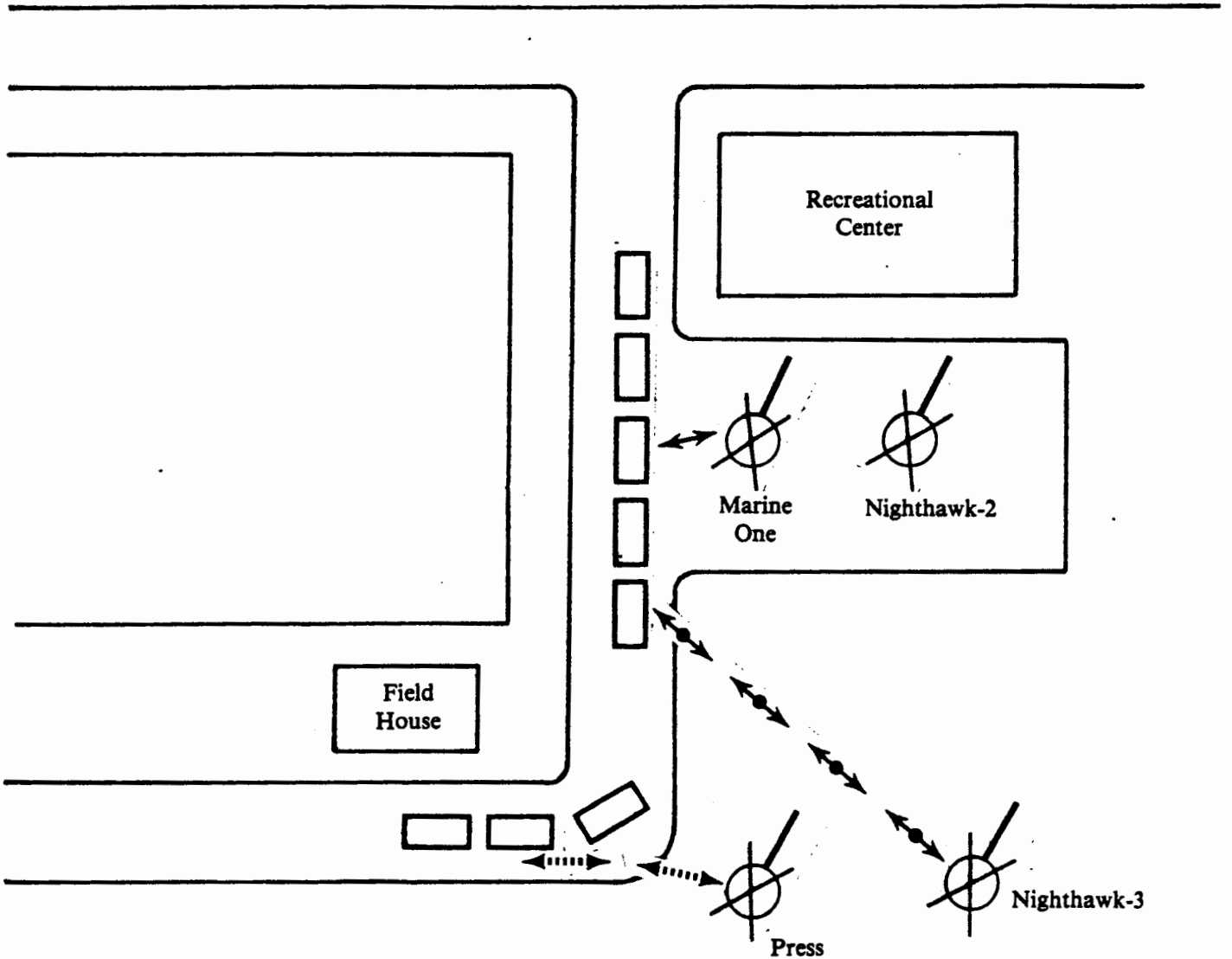

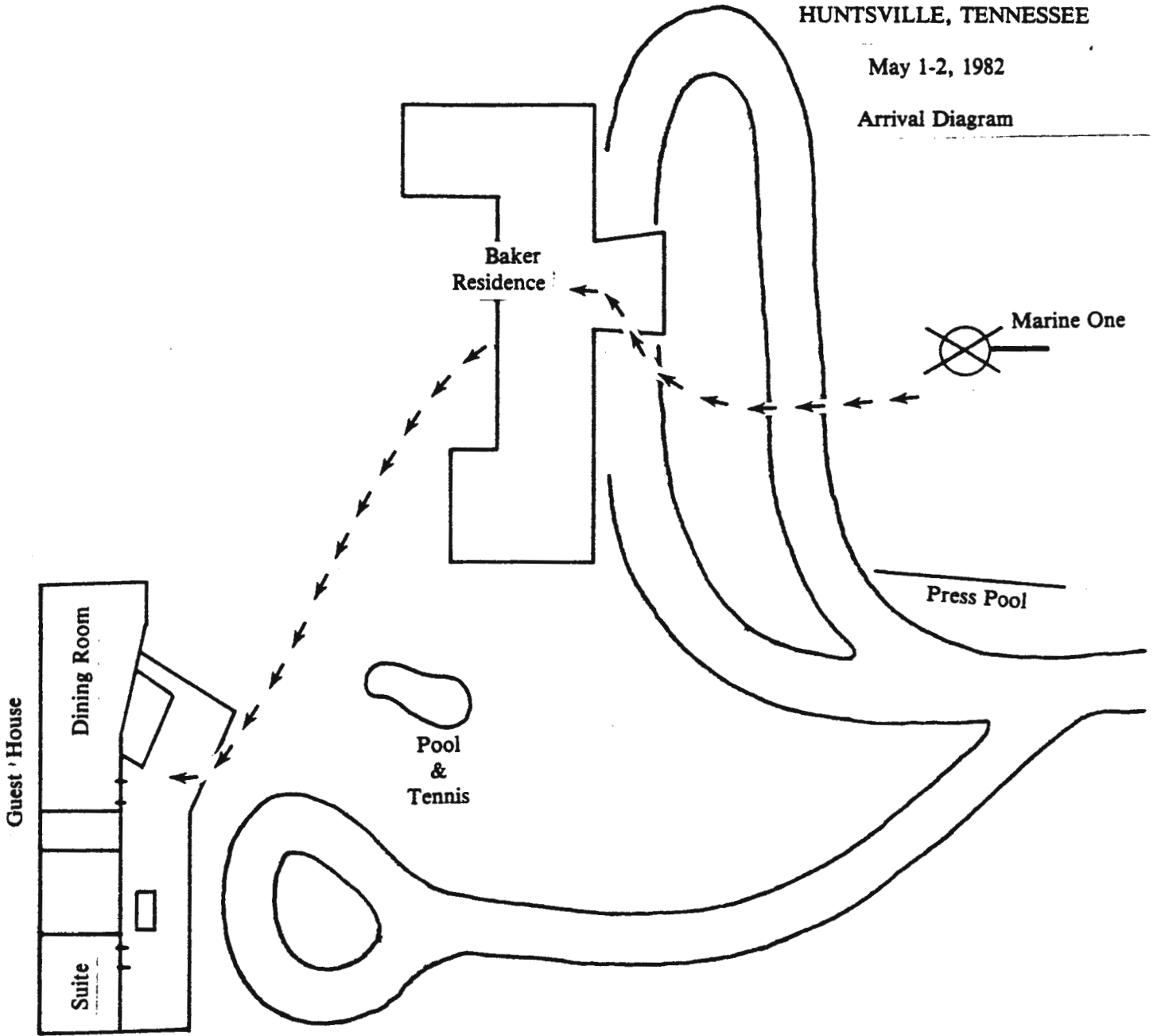

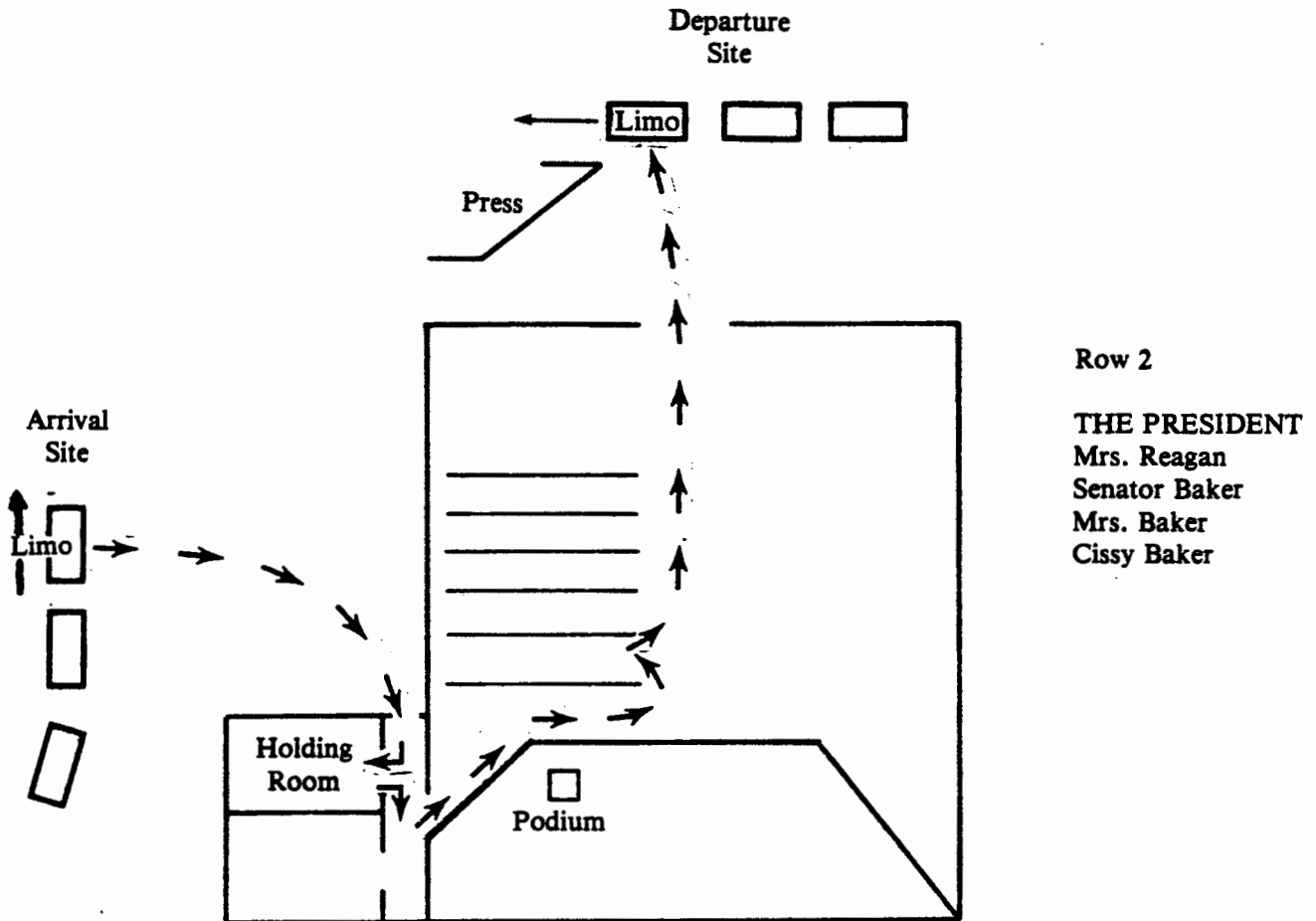

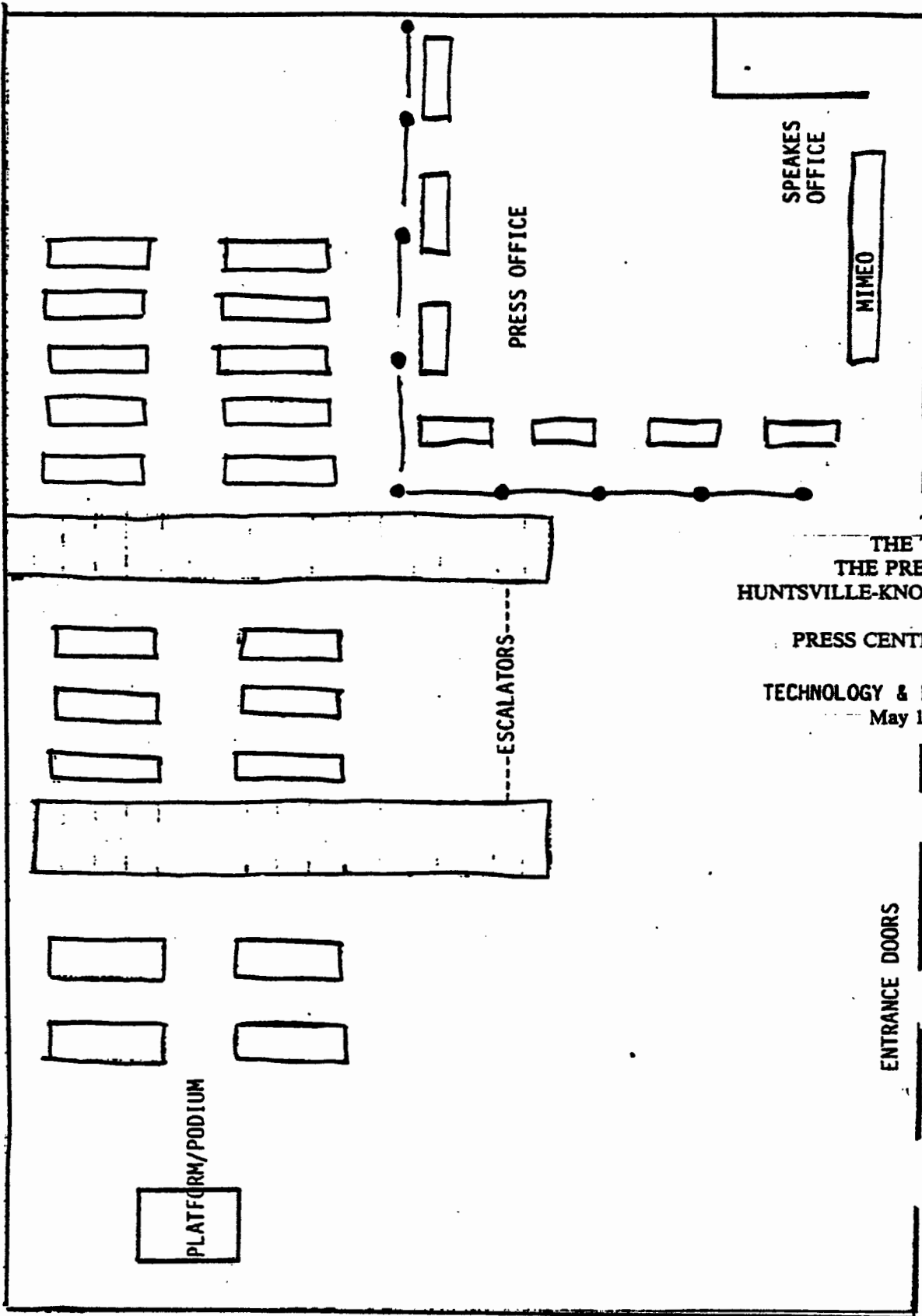
