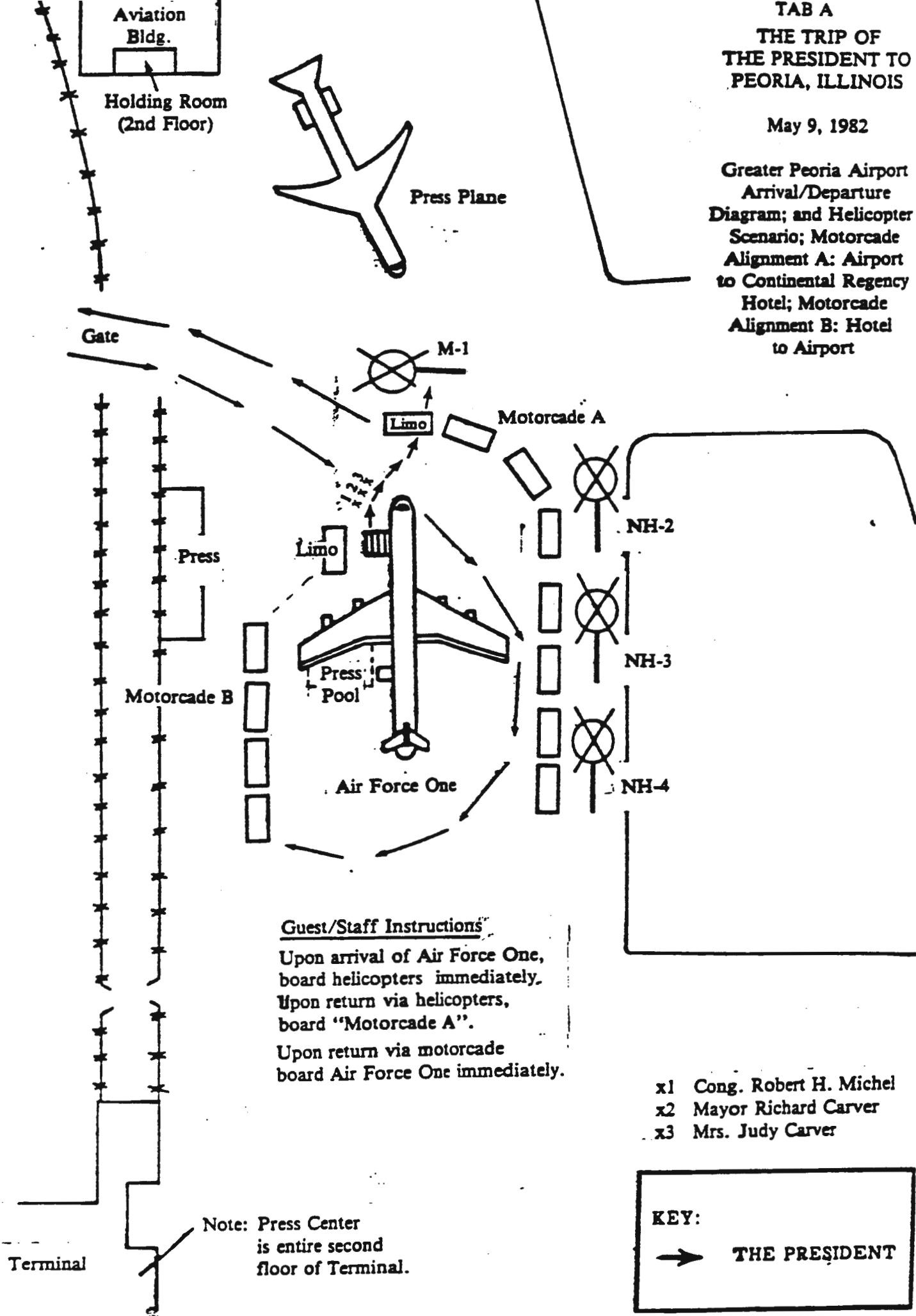

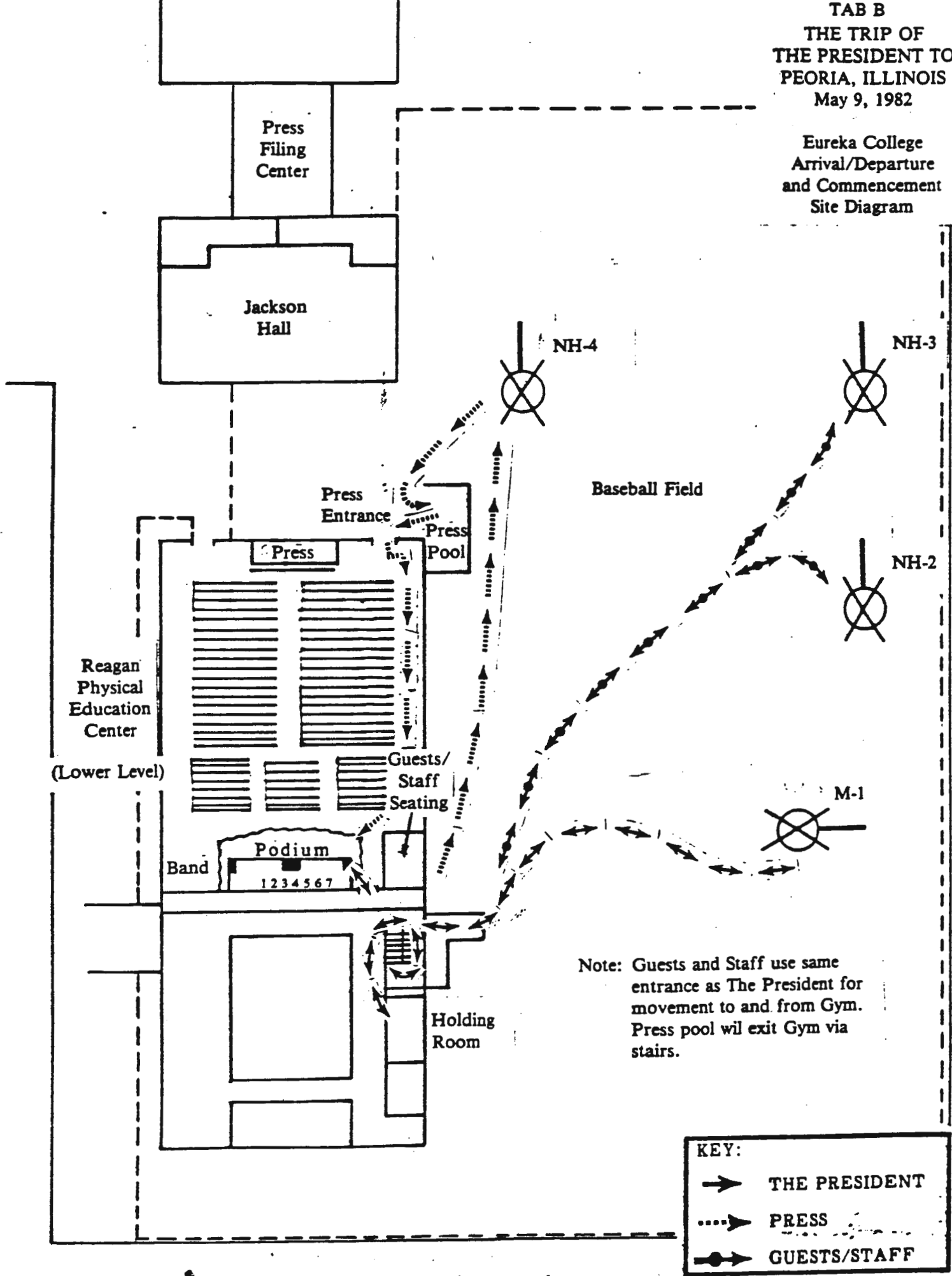

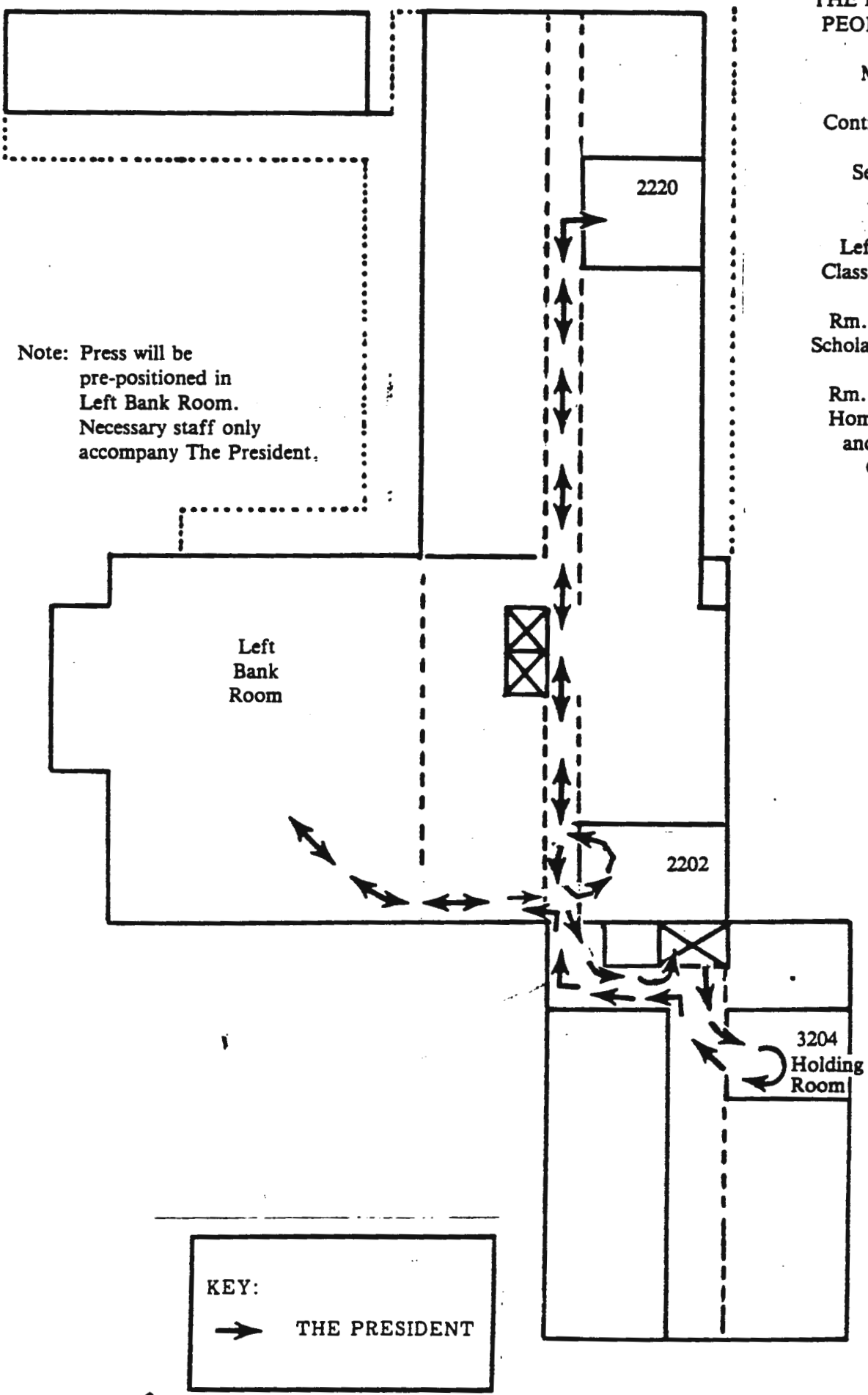

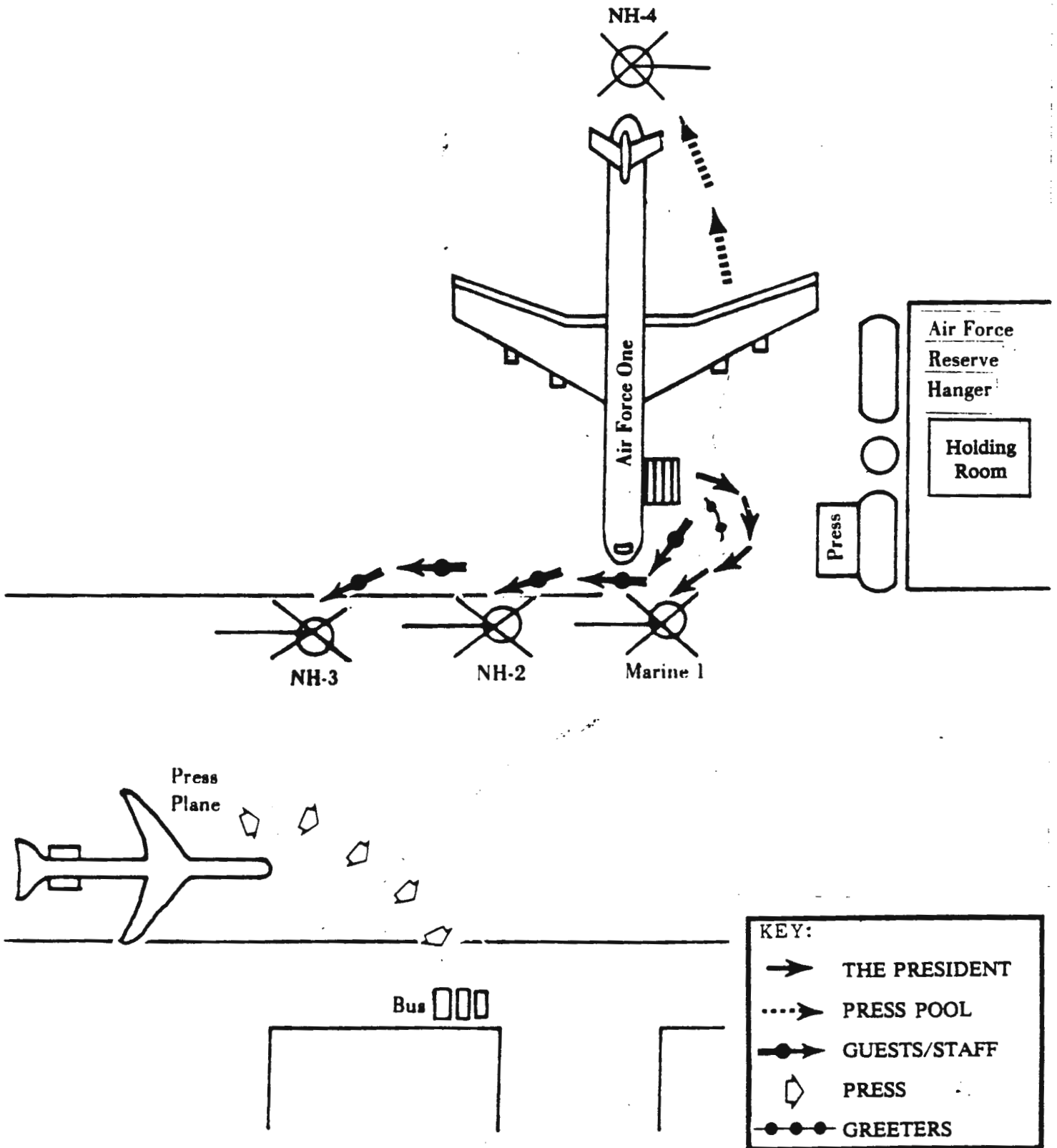

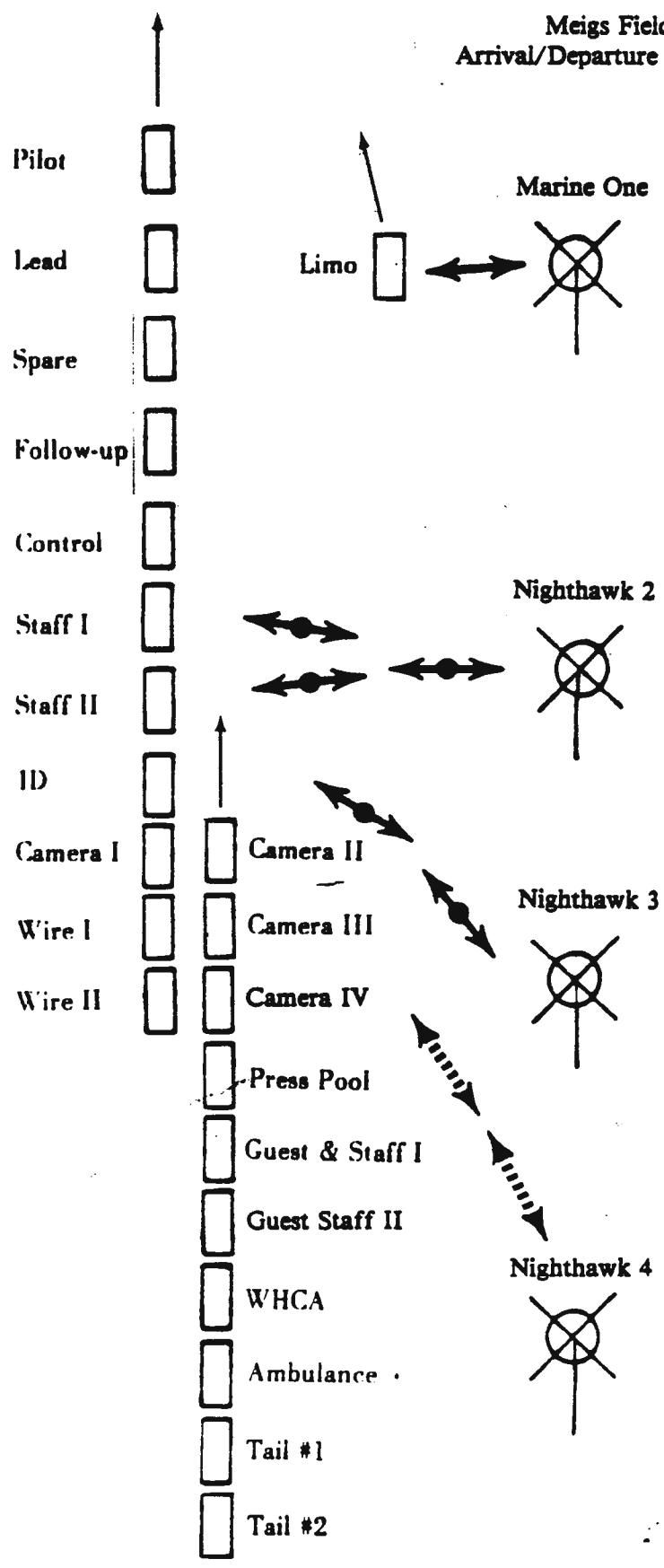
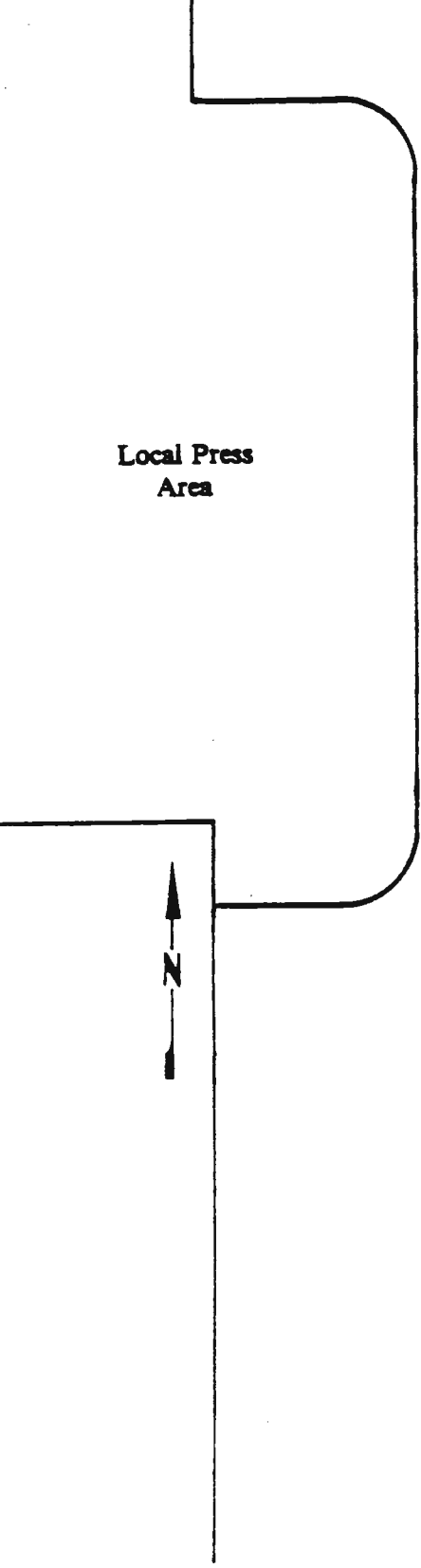
O'Hare International Airport

## Meigs Field Arrival/Departure Diagram



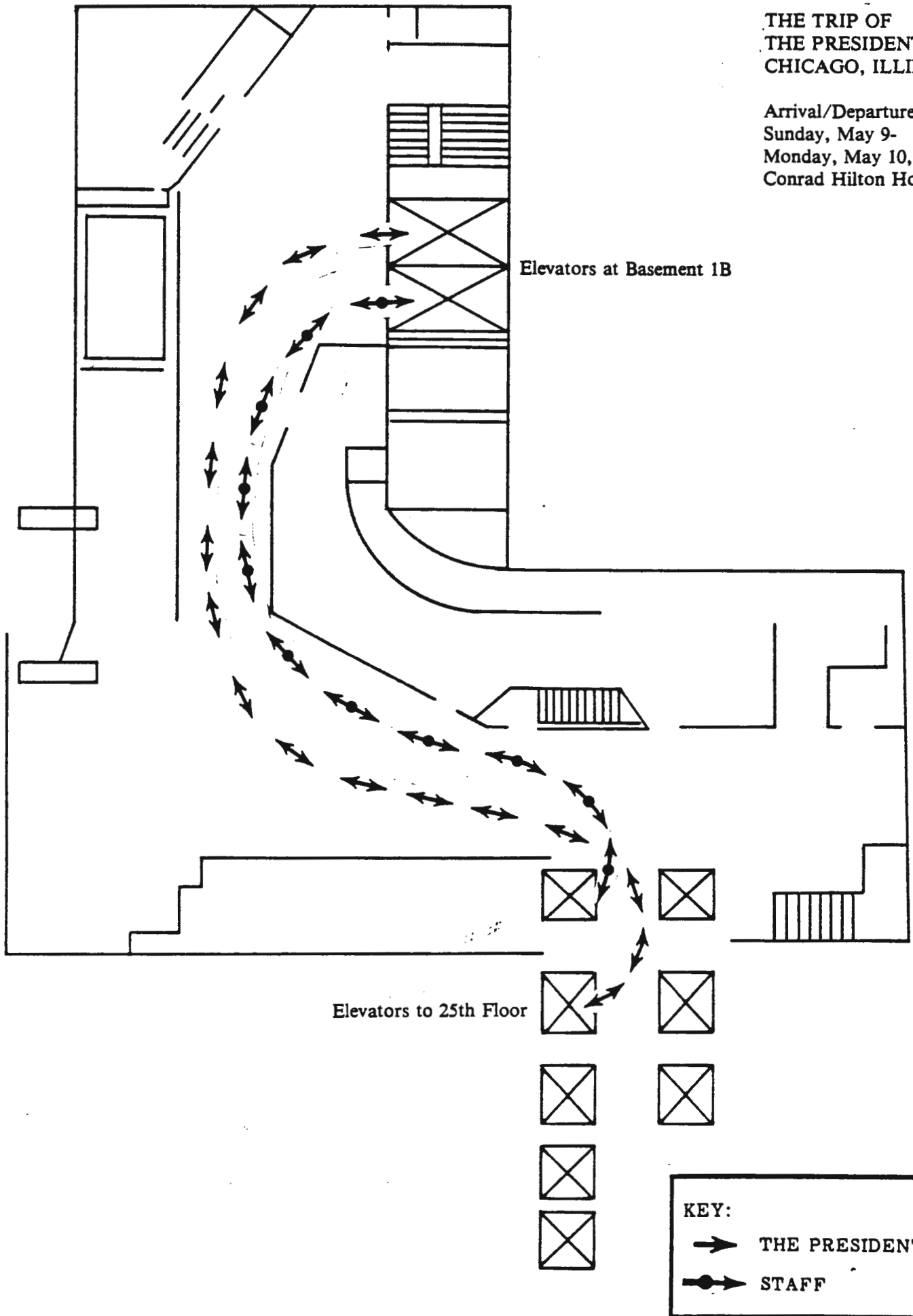

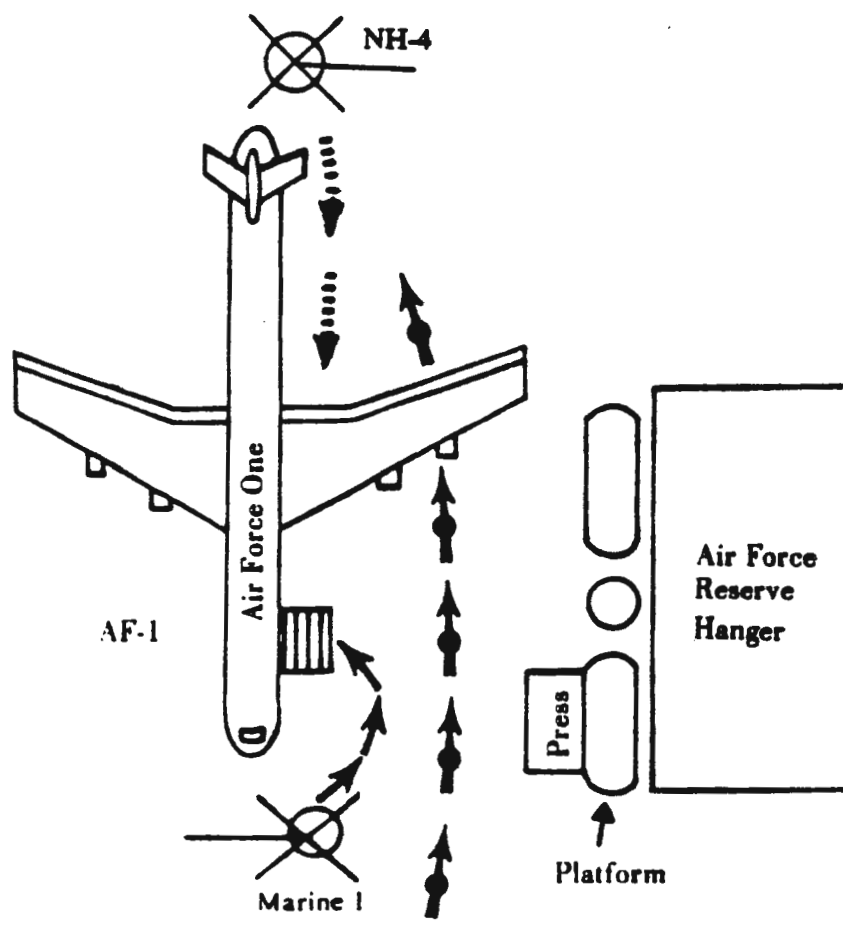

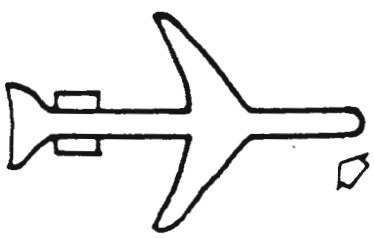
