To provide a briefing on the U.S. Space Program in order to set the stage for the President's approval of the National Space Policy and his remarks at the Shuttle landing on July 4.

II. BACKGROUND

An interagency working group has completed a draft National Security Decision Directive on National Space Policy. The document is in final coordination and will be ready for the President's signature during the week of June 28. Concurrently, the President plans to attend the landing of the fourth Shuttle flight at Edwards AFB, California, on July 4, assuming unforeseen circumstances do not intervene. As a prelude to both events, a briefing on the U.S. Space Program has been prepared to provide the President with necessary background information.
