PHONE CALL TO MICHIGAN RECEPTION HONORING DAVID STOCKMAN

Good evening, Jim. I hope you don't mind, but David never lets me phone long distance unless I call collect.

I hope you didn't put Dave in charge of the menu, tonight. The last time we tried that he suggested tuna fish, saltines and ketchup as a vegetable.

Seriously, I'm sure you all know how grateful I am for Dave's tireless work and steady counsel in our effort to bring runaway government to heel. You can be very proud of your hometown boy. I don't like to admit this too often to Dave, but I know we couldn't have achieved all that we have without him.

You good Republicans in Michigan's Fourth Congressional District have been steadfast, as well, and I appreciate it. Mark Siljander, who you sent to fill Dave's seat, has represented you well and I have counted on his advice and support.
