MEETING WITH FORMER NEW HAMPSHIRE GOVERNOR
MELDRIM THOMSON, JR.

I. PURPOSE

An opportunity for the President to meet with former New Hampshire Governor Meldrim Thomson and discuss Administration positions. The Governor has expressed concerns about the direction of the Administration and the need for more "conservatism", and has threatened to go public with his criticisms.

II. BACKGROUND

Governor Thomson, first elected Governor in 1972 and subsequently re-elected in 1974 and 1976 (but defeated in his bid to regain the governorship in 1978) is regarded as a leading conservative -- due not only to his outspokenness, but to the great attention given New Hampshire during campaign years. He threatened at one point in 1976 to run against President Ford in the Republican primary if Reagan declined to do so; although he supported Reagan very strongly.

GSA Administrator Jerry Carmen, long-time New Hampshire political operative, has learned in conversations with Thomson that he is distressed with the Administration's current directions -- so much to the point that he is considering running for President in 1984 as a favorite son candidate from New Hampshire.

Currently, Governor Thomson is founder and President of Equity Press, a law book publishing company specializing in Hispanic translations. He has established a reputation as an "expert" of sorts in Central American and Caribbean policies.

Jerry Carmen thought a few minutes with the President might assuage the Governor and keep him from "leaving the fold".
