I. PURPOSE

To present Presidential Rank Awards to Distinguished Senior Executives.

II. BACKGROUND

The Presidential Rank Award of Distinguished Senior Executives is the most prestigious recognition that can be given to a member of the Senior Executive Service.

The Civil Service Reform Act of 1978 was founded on the principle that employees should be compensated based on their performance and the 1983 Presidential Rank Awards are a reflection of that principle. There are 38 recipients of the 1983 Award. This will be the fourth consecutive year that these awards have been given.

Career SES members whose performance is exceptional for an extended period may be granted one of two Presidential ranks: "Distinguished Executive" or "Meritorious Executive." An individual may earn each award only once in any five-year period. Non-career or political appointees are not eligible for Presidential rank awards.

Each recipient will receive a framed certificate which you have signed, a distinctive gold lapel pin, and a check for \$20,000.


