# Administration Woos Church Policy Support



Two meetings between White House staffers and religious leaders this week didn't win the administration any converts on policy matters, but they did give mainline religious leaders as-

surance that they will have the same kind of access to the White House' they have had in previous adminis-

trations

There has been concern about White House access among mainline religious leaders who are at odds with President Reagan on a number of major domestic and foreign policy issues and out of sync with the Christian Right that was a key part

of his constituency.

Religious leaders know from experience that meetings with White House officials seldom change major policy directions, But they also know that it is important that any president receive accurate information about the views within the religious community and that White House contacts and functions do not send out a distorted picture of religion in America.

The situation was confused when the White House announced earlier this year that it would discontinue the position of special assistant for religious liaison begun under President Carter. But, in fact, the White House now has at least three staffers whose duties include contact with

religious groups:

• Morton Blackwell deals with Protestant groups. He reports to Diane Lozano, a deputy assistant to Elizabeth Dole, Reagan's assistant

for public liaison.

Jack Burgess, another deputy to Dole, is the contact for Catholic

groups.

Jacob Stein, as assistant to Burgess, deals with Jewish groups.

Dole and these assistants met on Tuesday with representatives of the Washington Interreligious Staff Council, a coalition of Washington representatives of national religious agencies running the gamut from the National Council of Churches to the National Association of Evangelicals, which is often regarded as a bridge between mainline denominations and the Christian Right.

Both Lozano and the Rev. Charles Bergstrom of the Lutheran Council in America, who helped set up the meeting, described it as "very positive." The WISC representatives made the point that many of their concerns are interreligious and that they do not want to deal with the White House on the basis of whether

they are Protestant, Catholic or Jewish. They were in turn assured that all staff assistants dealing with religious groups are ultimately responsible to Dole.

On Monday, about 170 religious leaders attended a briefing on administration budget, tax and regulatory policies. Blackwell said his office drew up the invitation list by contacting WISC, the Interfaith Conference of Metropolitan Washington and the National Association of Evangelicals and by using a list of church contacts developed during the campaign.

A quick examination of the invitation list and conversations with several people who attended the briefing indicate that while the Christian Right was disproportionately represented, moderate and liberal religious leaders — including strong critics of administration policies —

were amply represented.

The Rev. Ernest Gibson, director of the Council of Churches of Greatr Washington, says the first speaker, Manuel Johnson, deputy assistant secretary of treasury for tax policy, claimed that government had takeni over the church's role by getting into welfare programs and was now turning that role back to the churches. He said Johnson also said that tax cuts would free up more money for individuals who would increase their charitable contributions.

"I always thought government got into welfare programs because the problem was too big for churches and other charitable agencies to handle," Gibson said, adding that there is no guarantee that anyone will increase charitable contributions as a result of tax cuts.

The Rev. John Steinbruck, the activist pastor of Luther Place Memorial Church, also criticized the administration's economic policies; but he added a different dimension to the discussion, arguing that if the administration wants people to give more to charity, it should lead by example — "I gave more to charity last year than President Reagan and (Budget Director) David Stockman combined," he said. (Reagan gave \$3,000 on an income of \$225,000).


In a letter to Blackwell following up a conversation at Monday's briefing, Steinbruck said "may I again plead that you, the White House, at least share in the saving of your own neighborhood. My church. . is filled with homeless, hungry and sick who have dropped through the 'safety nets.' Our buildings are literally worn out from intensive use. Food is minimal.

"Our past requests have gone unanswered or refused for whatever reason. But I continue to plead because your White House personal example is vital if others are to catch the new spirit. If we can't save our own block, one may cynically ask, how can we hope to save the nation, let alone the world?"

### I. PURPOSE:

Since an earlier schedule commitment precludes your attendance at the School Prayer Day Rally on the Mall this evening, you agreed to hold a brief ceremony at the White House to light the candles of three young public school children. It is from these three candles that all those attending the evening's School Prayer Day Rally on the Mall will light their candles at 7:00 p.m. This same candlelighting ceremony will be replicated in the 50 States.

### II. BACKGROUND:

Project Prayer, the umbrella coalition of groups supporting voluntary school prayer, is sponsoring simultaneous rallies in each state and the District.
