CHANGES IN ISSUE FORECAST: On April 15 representatives of the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and Disabled American Veterans plus House Veterans Affairs Chairman, Congressman Sonny Montgomery (D.Miss) met with Dave Stockman in an attempt to work out an accommodation regarding proposed cuts to veterans programs. Depending on Director Stockman's response the veterans groups should either fully come on board the Reagan economic package coalition or grow increasingly critical.

By phone Don Moran agreed to direct V.A. acting administrator, Rufus Wilson to cease steps toward reduction in force which would have occurred under the Senate proposal but not under the Reagan bipartisan proposal in the House.
