Dear Mr. President:

December 27 through January 1, 1984 will see the largest gathering of Christian college students in the history of America. Campus Crusade for Christ, International will sponsor KC '83 which will attract 30,000 students representing virtually every four year college in our country and a delegate from over 100 nations around the world. This conference demonstrates the rapidly growing movement of Christian students on our campuses. These students will take the message of the love of God throughout the world and actively represent Biblical values throughout our society.

Knowing of your love for students, I am writing to invite you to address this great gathering via the electronic media. We would like to begin our conference, the evening of December 27th, with a five to ten minute video taped greeting from you. Immediately following the video we would like a brief, live telephone conversation between yourself and our Founder and President, Dr. William R. Bright.

Mr. President, your strong stand on school prayer and anti-abortion legislation has endeared you to the community of Christian college students. Your proclamation designating 1983 as "The Year of the Bible" has strengthened the convictions of many.
