### INTRODUCING

# EVANGELIST DR. LUDWIG OTTO

Early in 1953 my friend Ludwig sat in Stillmans' Gym in New York City on 8th Avenue. He was surrounded by his trainers, Whitey Bimstein and Freddie Brown. Rocky Graziano, the former Middleweight Champion, looked on as Freddie Brown removed the bandages from young Otto's hands. There was a jubilant air in the room. Ludwig had just finished sparring with Archie Moore, the Light Heavyweight Champ, and had turned in a good showing. As an undefeated professional prizefighter Ludwig had been rated the outstanding prospect in the Light Heavyweight division by Ring Magazine. He was on his way to boxing stardom. But there was something missing in his life.

During 1962 Ludwig was computer management executive with the National Cash Register Company. He was responsible for all 390 computer programming and business systems designing in the United States and Canada. A graduate of the City University of New York, he holds a Bachelor of Arts from that university and a Bachelor of Law from the Blackstone School of Law. At 28 years of age he was traveling extensively. **But there was something missing in his life.** 

In April of 1970 Ludwig Otto met with Joaquim Balaquer, President of the Dominican Republic. The room was filled with unspoken tension. Machine gun armed guards stood outside the doors of the Presidential Palace as Communist Revolutionaries threatened to topple the Pro-American Government. Later that night Ludwig Otto and his wife Sara and several Diplomats would flee the capital city of Santo Domingo for the relative safety of Boca Chico. As President and Chairman of the Board of a National Computer Company, Ludwig Otto was a millionaire and had been successful in introducing a novel new method of computerized constructin to President Balaquer. But something was missing in his life.

Then in January of 1971 Ludwig met Jesus Christ and life completely changed for him. God gave him a new life. He holds both a Master of Divinity and Doctor of Ministry degree from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. Since he met Jesus Christ his burning desire is to share with others what it means to be "born again" and how they can grow in the Lord Jesus.

He has pastored four great churches before responding to God's call to full-time evangelism. He is available to speak in your church, civic group or other place of meeting.
