Dear Bill,



Imperial Palace an ode to hard work

Whether you opt for the Moo Goo Gai Pan or go yum over the Long Island duckling will be pretty much beside the point by the time the evening is tucked away.

It's Dat Van Tran who'll stick out. And his wife Mary, too. Try to get funny and call them a peach of a pair, and that's about as flip as you should go.

When Tran slips into his socks and ties his shoes in the morning he certainly has to be a living testament to hard work.

Six years ago the Trans were in business at their Imperial Palace restaurant at Fifth and Bridge Streets in New Cumberland. It seated 20. Today it seats 150.

"We work 16 hours, six days a week," said Mrs. Tran, when asked to uncover the essential ingredient. "We are closed on Monday, but we use that day to get ready for Tuesday."

Mrs. Tran, an attractive toy-sized woman, did most of the talking during a post-lunch interview. Any superlatives she rendered could've been put together as an ode to America.

As for Tran, a squat man with some quick-silver silence about his features and purposeful gait, there was no way to prod or softsoap him into delineating the virtues of capitalism, just as he backed off from touting his braised tips of lamb.

It was in April 1975 when Tran forever turned thumbs down on communism. He and Mary and their nine children took to the boats as Saigon fell. In a way that feat was almost an out-of-the-blue miracle. Few families got away as intact as that.

Today they're still intact. All of the children work full or part-time in the Palace, with Bich Lien, 27, serving as hostess. Four have been or are in college — Penn State, Temple, Dayton U. — while the others are whetting skills of their own choosing.

"They all help," said Mrs. Tran. "Everybody knows what they have to do. They have their jobs."

This brush with success is not uncommon with the Trans. In Saigon they owned a 1,000-seat movie theater showing films international in flavor, with Charles Bronson and Robert Mitchum two of the big favorites. They also operated a 75-table restaurant, two small hotels and a villa.

They got out, said Mrs. Tran, with nothing. But success and the imperial red decor of the Palace will never hide completely a deep vein of sadness.

"There are many people dear to our hearts who are still there," said Mrs. Tran. "There are kinfolks, friends and just our country itself."

Saigon was a very beautiful city. We were crushed.

"But now there is America."

On the wall behind the Palace's cash register is a letter thanking the Trans for their letter thanking the writer for his part in their rescue and new life. It is dated 1978 and was written by former President Gerald R. Ford.

Nearby is a large glass-enclosed key to the borough of New Cumberland and a letter from a man in back of the presentation, then-Mayor Leonard W. Sorenson. The letter is a slap on the back for the industry, aims and hard work of the Trans.

Yet, the most eye-catching feature has to be the hand-woven and flower-patterned silk screens just inside the door. They're beguiling, almost lulling, but Tran knows as only his 50 hard-won years can tell him, that they sing of the past.

Putting aside a cup of tea, he hears work calling. There is shrimp and veal to order, and somebody's at the back door with bean sprouts.

We want to tell you how much we appreciate your great speech to the World at the U.N. Monday. We are with you 100%.

Your words express your understanding and wisdom of the lies and danger of world communist power, we just trust all America will back you up and that the free world can stay free and strong.

We had worked hard and were blessed at being at the top in our native country of Viet Nam. When our country fell we fled for our lives and lost all, but thanks to the wisdom of President Gerald Ford and his actions we were able to come to America to freedom and a new life.

Inclosed you will find a copy of the letter President Gerald Ford wrote to us in 1973, we are thankful and proud of this good letter.

Thanks again for your words and strong leadership.

We join our prayers with millions that God will lead and bless you and America in this great time in History.

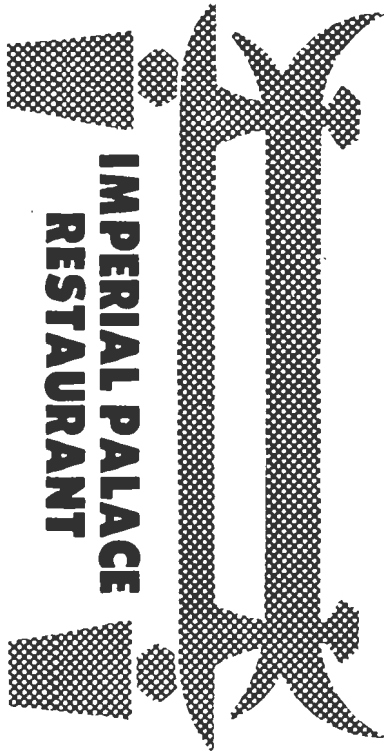

A project to present each member of Congress with a copy of My Life Without God, a testimony of Bill Murray, has been initiated by Wayne Neal, missionary to Capitol Hill, Washington, D.C. Rev. Neal will deliver these books in person with a personal cover letter.

Rev. Neal started to minister in this area of outreach in 1974 when he worked as coordinator with Sam Houston Johnson, LBJ's brother. Rev. What Atheism Is

**By One Who Has Gone From
Atheism To Christianity**

The son of atheist Madalyn Murray O'Hair, Bill Murray was himself an outspoken crusader for atheism. But today he is one of America's leading spokesmen for Christianity. The message that follows was given at Sweetwater Church of the Valley in November of 1980.

What Atheism Is

BY ONE WHO HAS GONE FROM
ATHEISM TO CHRISTIANITY

It's often difficult for people to understand where I'm coming from because they don't really know what atheism is. It is difficult for people who have been raised in Christian homes and exposed to positive Bible truths to comprehend the negativism of atheism.

Many people think that an atheist is just someone that does not believe in God, but it's more than that. That's like saying a Christian is someone that believes in God. But being a Christian is a lot more than just believing in God; it is knowing Jesus Christ as your personal savior, knowing that you have eternal life, and that you have come out of the darkness into the light. Christianity is a way of life. And so is atheism.

First, no matter what you call atheism, it's still atheism. You can call it humanism — and a lot of our children are being taught humanism in public schools today.

In humanism or atheism the individual is all-important. The family, the home and mankind are all secondary, and the Church, Christ, and God are not important at all. The family influenced by the atheist/humanist philosophy will be a family with real problems, because if

the individual is the most important thing, then he will have to have his own way in order to be happy. And to do that he has to dominate other people.

If you are the one with the strength and will to dominate, then there will be resentment and hatred from those you dominate. If you try to dominate and fail, then you will be the one with resentment and hatred. Either way you go, there is resentment and hatred inside that kind of a family. That's the kind of situation I was raised in, and that's the kind of situation many children are being raised in today.

There are three basic tenets to atheism/humanism:

1. There is no God.
2. There is no hereafter.
3. There are no absolutes.

And as terrible as the first two are, perhaps the third one — there are no absolutes — is the most dangerous of all. In the Bible we have absolutes, the Lord makes it quite plain: "Thou shalt not kill. Thou shalt not steal. Thou shalt not covet." The atheistic/humanistic dogma says, "Thou shalt not kill *unless* . . . Thou shalt not steal *unless* . . . Thou shalt not covet *unless* . . ." And this is what our children are being taught in the public schools.

For example, in one textbook by Dr. Sidney Simon, the author of *Values Classification* and *Values Education* textbooks, the child is told to put himself in the following situation:

First, he is to pretend he is a god. He is in a lifeboat which will only support five people, but there are ten on board. The child must decide which five people are to live. Actually, the child is being told to pick five people to die. The child, however, will only have to pick four other people to stay in the boat, because being raised in a humanist school with humanist ideas, he knows at least one person who is going to stay on the boat — himself.

Inevitably the group from which he must choose includes a minister, a pregnant woman, and an old man. The old man probably has enough wisdom to save all ten people, but he goes overboard. The minister goes overboard. The pregnant woman goes overboard because she has two mouths to feed. Nothing fits the

humanist/atheist philosophy except the young, the strong, the virile, and those who can force their ideas down the throats of others. *That's the only way it works.*

In my opinion, one of the most dangerous men in America today is Dr. Paul Kurtz, president of the American Humanist Association. I have a filmed interview with him during which he is asked whether killing is right or wrong. He replied that it depended upon the situation.

If I asked, "What, for example?" he would reply, "Abortion — it's a woman's right to be able to dispose of something inside of her body. And euthanasia (mercy killing) — you are being kind to someone that is unconscious, in a coma, or too old to know what he is doing, by putting them to sleep." He also says that in any given situation, the person doing the killing has to consider all the aspects of what he is doing. But in all that he said, however, he never brought up one person's opinion — the one who would be killed.

I've wondered what Dr. Kurtz would think if he were lying in a hospital, desperately ill, and I walked in and looked down at him and said, "Remember what you said?" Fortunately, he wouldn't have to worry, because I wouldn't do anything. I don't believe in it. There in lies the difference between Christianity and atheism/humanism.

In Christianity, we will defend our lives, our families, and our property, but we will not go out and purposely, as a matter of philosophy, destroy other human lives.

Atheism/humanism as well as communism, denies the supernatural, denies divine revelation, and promotes a one-world government. They all say that a new man has to be created to provide the super-race. We saw what Hitler, Satlin, and Mao Tse-tung did to create the super-race. In order to create the super-race you have to get rid of the old order. You do that with guns, gas chambers, or whatever else you can.

Those who remember World War II may also remember a political party in Germany and the United States called the National Socialist Workers People's Party. (You won't read this name in our history books, though, because it

has been removed from them. The history texts call it the Nazi Party.) How could anyone be against a political party with such a nice sounding name — it's for the nation, the workers, and the people . . . ? By the same token, how could anyone be against the American Humanist Association? But let us consider the parallels between the two groups.

The American Humanist Association is in favor of abortion and euthanasia (mercy killing). Was it not the policy of the National Socialist Workers People's Party in Germany to take the elderly out and allow them to die? Was it not their policy to allow people of certain races and ethnic backgrounds to abort their children and have sterilization forced upon them? Does that sound familiar? Christians in the United States are not promoting these things, but many American humanists and atheists are.

Our children are being taught in the public schools that it's okay to do these things. And if you are not aware that they are being taught these concepts, it's because at one point in Dr. Simon's textbook the children are explicitly told **not** to tell their parents what is being discussed in school.

Recently a pilot sex education program of the *Values Classification/Values Education* was put forth by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare. In this program, twelve-year-old girls were going to be taken to abortion clinics to practice filling out forms so they would be able to use them later. Seven and

eight year-old children were going to be taken into each other's restrooms, and boys and girls were going to be encouraged to have homosexual encounters so they would be able to make a reasonable choice when they grew up.

This pilot program was just barely stopped in California, and the individuals who put the text and program together have sworn to rewrite it to make it acceptable. I'm not sure how they will do that, but the plans are to introduce it in 1981 as a pilot and by 1982 have it in federally funded schools all across the United States.

No wonder parents complain about their children's behavior. The children are being taught: 1) if it feels good, do it, and 2) the only thing you have to worry about is getting caught. You don't have to worry about anybody "up there" — that's something old-fashioned and doesn't matter any more

Twenty years ago, when my family was instrumental in taking the Bible out of public schools, a rape in a classroom was an unusual thing. Now it happens every day in every city. It's happening to the same people who are teaching our children that it only matters if you get caught.

Something New in Evolution

Let me tell you about the newest development in evolution (Darwinism). This theory, as it was taught in our schools, has been thrown out the window and will no longer be taught. Don't cheer yet — they have something new to replace it.

In Darwinism, you remember, we were taught about slow evolution where the fish slowly grew legs and crawled up on the land, then later stopped having eggs and gave birth to little mammals. But no one was ever able to find any skeletal remains or missing links between the species. No skulls were found that were supposed to precede man, and no transition bones were found between small horses and big horses. It was a nice imaginary thing, but it didn't work — so now we have a new theory.

Are you ready for this. It's called "The Benevolent Monster Theory". I'm serious. It goes like this:

There was a fish, and all of a sudden it gave birth to a lizard that had legs and breathed air. And there was a monkey, and it gave birth to something without fur that was called a human being — and even though the monkey thought it was ugly, she said, "Well, it's mine. I'll keep it." And that's why we are here today. This, of course, explains why there are no fossils showing the transition and development of a species.

This will be taught next semester in our public schools as the fact — not the theory — of how evolution works.

And speaking of evolution, one of the tenets of humanism/atheism is that the strongest always survive. Theoretically that should mean that we don't have to send our strong young men to fight anymore. But unfortunately it isn't the strongest that survive. In the history of mankind, it has always been the strongest, the bravest, and the most intelligent that perished while defending the liberties, freedoms, and integrity of the weak. The strongest don't even survive on a chicken farm. The strongest roosters kill each other — and guess who gets the chickens?

In order to convince me that atheism or humanism will work, someone will have to prove to me that man is basically good and has never sinned, and that the one-world philosophy preached by the humanists and atheists works.

The American Humanist Association Continues to Win Victories

The American Humanist Association went to the Supreme Court in 1963 and 1967 in order to have itself classified as a religion and is now officially a religion for tax purposes. It is treated by the Internal Revenue Service as a church, with the same privileges as any church. However, when it comes to teaching their dogma in the schools, they say, "We are a secular organization and therefore our dogma can be taught in the schools."

Our children can be exposed to their dogma, but they cannot be exposed to Christianity . . . How far has this gone? Recently, in Maryland the Supreme Court ruled that the Gideons

could not place Bibles in the libraries of the Maryland public schools. Just how far has the humanist influence gone in our country?

The San Francisco City Council recently ordered the police chief that henceforth thirty percent of all new recruits for the San Francisco Police Department had to be homosexual. This is part of the "lifestyle" idea. People say, "It's only a lifestyle. Homosexuals are no different from anyone else. They are happy-go-lucky people. That's why they call them 'gay'."

If they are so gay, why do they have the highest suicide rate of any group in this nation? These people are ill. They are suffering from a spiritual, mental, and physical illness. They need to be helped and ministered to, not put in positions of authority.

Why I Turned From Atheism

I had been away from my family and from atheism for about eleven years. I wasn't a Christian; I wasn't anything. I was just minding my own business, climbing the corporate ladders and stepping on people like any other good American. I was buying better homes, bigger cars, nicer suits, trying to intimidate my employees and my friends. I wasn't doing the Christian thing, but I was doing the American thing, as the humanists see it.

My mother came to me in 1975 — and let me say here that I have no animosity towards my mother. I love her and I pray for her, but I cannot forsake Jesus Christ for her — and she

asked me to come to Austin, Texas, and help her with her organization. My stepfather was dying, and she said, "Bill, my organization is dying. My magazine hasn't been printed in years, my newsletter hasn't been printed in months. I can't afford to pay a secretary, and our organization is in a little two-room frame house."

So I went to Austin, Texas, taking along a printing plant and half a dozen people who owed me favors. We built the American Atheist Center in a period of eighteen months. We moved it from a two-room office into a 20,000 square foot office building.

In the almost two years that I was there, I was almost destroyed. I found out what it was like to be stepped on. Up until then, I had been doing the stepping, but now I was with professional steppers. I was with people who lived, breathed, and practiced the philosophy of atheism and humanism. I couldn't handle it. I was devastated by the activity in that organization. The resentment and hatred was unbelievable.

But there was one incident that broke me. I owed a favor to a little hospital in Georgetown, Texas. They needed some new equipment, and I said, "You know Mom, you could really make a name for yourself and the atheists by doing something constructive for that hospital. We could use some of the excess capital that we've made in the last two years and buy the x-ray machine they need. It's only about \$70,000. You could put a plaque on it that says, 'Donated by Madalyn Murray O'Hair, American Atheists'."

I was almost laughed out of the place. They said to me, "You're silly. We've got more important things to do with that money. We need to sue to get the words 'In God We Trust' taken off the currency. We need to sue to stop astronauts from saying prayers in outer space."

It suddenly dawned on me what atheism really is. It's pure negativism. My mother and her associates weren't interested in the x-ray machine for the hospital or the people who would be helped by it — but if that hospital had a religious name on the front of it, they would

have been more than happy to file a suit to get the name changed.

With that I packed up and left. I left my printing plant, my \$85,000. house that was under construction, and I went to Tucson, Arizona and opened a little book store.

I sat and stared at it for six months and let it go bankrupt because I didn't know where to go or what to do.

I had been raised with one philosophy and that philosophy didn't work. How would you like to be raised as a Christian and find out that Christianity didn't work? I was raised as an atheist and found out that atheism didn't work.

I looked everywhere to find the name and nature of God. I now knew He must exist. I looked into all the world's religions and read hundreds of books. But there was only one book where I found the truth. The Bible. And in the Bible I came to know the truth, and came to know the Lord Jesus Christ as my personal savior.

A New Direction

I would have been more than happy just to keep quiet about it for a while, but, as you know, you really can't do that, and word got out about the change in my life. It wasn't too long before I received a telephone call from the office of Congressman Bill Crane of Illinois. They had heard a rumor about me, and Congressman Crane wanted to know if I would come to Washington D.C. and give my opinion as to whether prayer should be reinstated in public schools.

So I went to Washington and testified in behalf of Senate Bill 450 and helped Congressman Crane lobby for that bill. The bill was written by Senator Jesse Helms, and he was successful in getting it passed in the Senate, but it got stuck in the House with only thirty signatures.

Then Bill Bright of Campus Crusade for Christ and Jerry Falwell of "The Old Time Gospel Hour," along with myself and others, obtained 187 more signatures for the bill within twenty-four hours, but we were still about forty signatures short. As the House session closed and the representatives returned to their home

states for elections, the bill never got to the floor of the House.

After the election, a most interesting thing was observed: of the more than eighty individuals who refused to sign Bill Crane's discharge petition in order to call a vote on it, only eight are returning to the House of Representatives. Many of these men had received letter after letter from the people in their home states calling for a return of this nation to the principles of the Bible, but they didn't listen. So this time the people sent them letters they could understand — those letters simply said, "Come home."

Today we are involved in a great crusade. We are in a desperate fight with the forces of humanism and atheism. Our organization, The Faith Foundation, has been raised up to join in this battle against these forces of darkness.

One of the most important aspects of the Faith Foundation's literature and the messages which I am able to share throughout this country is that they can be readily understood by the secular people who need to find a faith in God. I am able to get the point across to the atheists and the humanists because I was raised as an atheist. I know the pain, but I also know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

Values Clarification and the Christian

Values Clarification and the Christian

During the mid 1960's several social scientists developed a teaching method called **Values Clarification**. They claimed it to be the way to teach values to school age children without taking any one moral position. The basis of this philosophy of teaching was the belief that no absolute values existed or as its proponents put it, values were "personal things." Thus, such educators as Dr. Sidney Simon and Merrill Harmin told us that instructing a student that stealing or murder is wrong was incorrect. They also told us that teaching such values as honesty or loyalty was equally incorrect. Their theory contended that the teacher should do no more than help the student "clarify" his own values. The course of **Values Clarification** came to be widely used.

Richard A. Baer, in his article for the *Wall Street Journal*, titled "Parents, Schools and Values Clarification", pointed out that **Values Clarification** ". . . use in public school sex-education classes and by local Planned Parenthood groups was particularly noteworthy, for whether intended or not, adolescents were in effect given the message that parents, the school or society had no right to tell them what standards should guide sexual behavior." Mr. Baer who is an associate professor at New York State College continued that, "Whether premarital sex was right or wrong, for instance, adolescents would discover for themselves as they were helped to clarify their personal values."

At first only parents objected to these courses. Many, who were Christians, were publicly criticized by educators and school officials as "old-fashioned" or "anti progressive education." Now, however, many "progressive" educators are questioning the value of **Values Clarification** themselves. Men such as St. John's College president Edwin J. Delattre and Cornell professor Kenneth Strike have virtually agreed with the nation's parents and with religious fundamentalists.

Mr. Delattre points out that **Values Clarification** does not take a neutral position on ethical questions as its proponents say. In fact he says it . . . "emphatically indoctrinates . . . by

encouraging and even exhorting the student to narcissistic self-gratification."

Returning to Mr. Baer's paper he concludes that **Values Clarification** "By affirming the complete relativity of all values, . . . in effect equate values with personal tastes and preferences." The systems gravest area is in the reaction of the student. He writes:

"If parents object to their children using pot or engaging in pre-marital sex, the theory behind **Values Clarification** makes it appropriate for the child to respond, 'but that's just **your** value judgement. Don't force it on me'."

To force the teachers in our schools to reinforce their belief system its proponents, such as Dr. Simon, belittle teachers who attempt to teach traditional values. These proponents must do this as their doctrine is basically anti-religious, anti-family, and anti-society. This philosophy teaches that the individual is the final source of judgement on any issue, that values are determined "out of personal choices." The ultimate purpose then of **Values Clarification** is to teach the individual that self-fulfillment should be his ultimate goal. Being in the service of God, country or one's fellow man is secondary or non-existent to this philosophy of life.

According to Mr. Baer there is also the legal question of separation of church and state. **Values Clarification** fosters a religion which teaches that each man is the center of his Universe. (A traditional American Indian belief.) Thus the religious beliefs of Hindus, Christians, Jews, etc., are being violated by the forced instruction of this "alternate" religion.

Many of the educators that scoffed at fundamentalist Jewish and Christian criticism of **Values Clarification** are now speaking out against it. Why? Lawyers in felony cases against juveniles in the U.S. courts have begun using **Values Clarification** as a defense. Their clients, they claim, were taught by the state that no such thing as 'right' or 'wrong,' existed. Since the state instructed them that nothing was 'wrong' how could that same state now prosecute the individual for doing 'wrong.'

We must return moral instruction to our schools. Absolute right and absolute wrong does exist. Those values learned and taught by the fathers of this country are available today. Those same values that have always been available in the Word of God.


I do not care if I am called a fool for the sake of Christ. I would rather be HIS fool than the leader of any nation on this earth.

U.S. is still best alternative to communism, Cleaver says

America is still the world's best alternative to communist oppression, Eldridge Cleaver, an Arkansas native, former Black Panther leader and Marxist-turned-Christian, said Friday.

Cleaver said America's domestic problems could be solved if approached spiritually, as well as economically and politically.

Cleaver, William Murray, son of atheist Madalyn Murray O'Hair, and W. Cleon Skousen, president of the Freeman Institute, held a press conference at the Little Rock Airport before going to Searcy to participate in the fifth annual Christian Awareness Seminar at Harding University today.

Cleaver said he would detail his experiences of growing up in America, becoming disillusioned and turning to communism and spending eight years in exile in communist countries before returning to the United States and facing charges stemming from a deadly shootout with Oakland, Calif., police.

In the process, he said, a spiritual change of going from a "snotty-nosed atheist" who con-

sidered religion a "tool of oppression," to a born-again Christian took place in his life.

Murray said his presentation would be similar to Cleaver's, except that he was raised in a Marxist, communist home in Baltimore.

In 1960 his family attempted to defect to the Soviet Union. They were refused, he said, because the Soviets thought his mother was just another "kook."

This indirectly led to the June 17, 1963, ban on religion in the public schools, Murray said, because it was after the family had returned from Paris - where they had gone to meet the Soviets halfway - and he was enrolled in public school that his mother found out about school prayer and the pledge of allegiance.

Murray is now a Christian and founder of the William J. Murray Faith Foundation Inc. of Dallas, where he is working to bring prayer and bible reading back to the public schools.

Skousen, of Salt Lake City, is founder of the Freeman Institute, whose purpose is to return to constitutional principles established by the founding fathers.

Skousen said few Americans would go through the experiences that Cleaver and Murray had. Too many people take this country for granted, but it is still the hope of the free world for half the countries of the world, he said. We need to "sit down and look at some of the things that have made us great."

He said a "boom and bust cycle" - five years of boom and three years of bust - had been built into the economy. He favors balancing the budget, returning to gold and silver as the monetary base and doing away with the Federal Reserve System, which he said manipulates the "boom and bust" cycle for special interests.

Cleaver said his living in communist countries had made him aware of plans to destroy this country. "I think the last thing we need in America is violent revolution," he said.

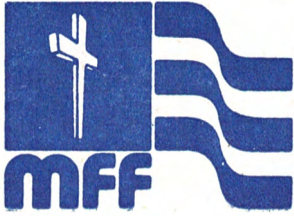
He said there were still racial problems and faults in the economy. To be adequately resolved, he said, the problems must be addressed spiritually, economically and politically.

Cleaver will be running for mayor of Oakland, Calif., in April, he said.

Nationals on the Job

Nigerian missionaries will soon be living among two more previously unreached groups in this West African nation—30,000 Bokus, who live in western Nigeria, and 4,000 Komas, who live in eastern Nigeria. The response came after Nigerian missionaries visited the areas and led 50 people to the Lord. The chief of the Komas asked for Christians to "live among us and teach us the way to really follow Jesus." The Bokus expressed similar concern over the absence of help for Christian growth and further evangelism.

New Religious Survey

Latest reports indicate that religious preference in the U. S. stands at 59 percent Protestant, 28 percent Roman Catholic, 2 percent Jewish, and 11 percent uncommitted. 41 percent go to church regularly, one out of three watches a weekly religious program on TV, and one out of six reads the Bible daily. 37 percent view the Bible as the literal Word of God (down from 65 percent in 1963). 42 percent view it as divinely inspired but not to be taken literally (up from 18 percent in 1963).

National Prayer

May 5th has been proclaimed by President Reagan as a national day of prayer for our nation. The week preceding May 5th will be a time of prayer, repentance, and humility before God. Among the sponsors are Dr. Bill Bright of Campus Crusade for Christ and Dr. Pat Robertson, host of the 700 Club.

House Churches in China

TransWorld Radio has commenced broadcasting a training and teaching program for leaders of the rapidly growing house church movement in mainland China.

Hindu Converts

Operation Mobilisation India reports that 40,000 persons have reconverted to the Hindu religion during the last 19 years. Of the new entrants into the Hindu fold, 90 percent are Christians.

Pornographer of the Month

The National Federation for Decency recently began making a "Pornographer of the Month" award to companies advertising in pornographic magazines such as *Playboy* and *Penthouse*. More than 25 major advertisers have told the Federation they will discontinue advertising in such magazines.

Church Property and Bars

The U.S. Supreme Court declared unconstitutional a Massachusetts law that gave churches and schools the power to veto the issuing of liquor licenses within 500 feet of their property. Chief Justice Warren Burger wrote the 8-1 opinion and claimed that the law violated the constitutionally required separation of church and state. The ruling does not automatically overturn similar laws in 27 other states.

Unofficial Chinese Church Closed

Chinese authorities have closed Canton's last and largest church operating outside the auspices of the government when members refused to register as a government-approved church. They say the Three-Self Movement sanctioned by the government as the Protestant churches' overseer would control its religious activities and that it has instituted unbiblical restrictions.

A Victory for Christian Schools

A Michigan judge reaffirmed the First Amendment guarantee of separation of church and state by exempting private Christian schools from state supervision of their curriculum and teachers. Judge Ray Hotchkiss ruled against the state board of education, stating that imposing its secular standards of education on religious schooling interfered with the schools' right to freely exercise their religion.

Brazil and Missions

The Unevangelized Fields Mission has signed a contract with the Brazilian National Indian Foundation to conduct education and health work among several tribal groups in Brazil's rainforest interior. The contract insures a continuing witness to the Kayapo, Canela, and Guajajara Indians.

Church Vandalized

A 500-member Korean church in Elmhurst, Illinois, near Chicago, has been vandalized and its building burned. \$250,000 worth of damage was done. The group had bought a school building despite some neighborhood protest and had turned it into a church. The development of Korean churches, almost all strongly evangelical, is an example of remarkable church growth. About 80 such congregations exist in the Chicago area alone.

Thailand

Buddhism is the official religion of Thailand, but the people are free to choose the religion they want. The Far Eastern Broadcasting Crusade has good coverage of the whole country through local stations. There are listeners' rallies and a video cassette ministry in their own languages for refugees. Recently FEBC received an award from Thailand's Department of Education because their programs are "contributing to the cause of national peace and stability."

Missionary Cleared

Veteran missionary Jennie Adams in Peru has been cleared of all charges of drug trafficking and released after spending 20 days in jail. Hitchhikers picked up by Miss Adams were carrying 4 kilos of refined cocaine for delivery to a police officer in Trujillo. All were imprisoned, and Peruvian press had a field day calling Miss Adams' missionary ministry a coverup for drug trafficking. It was clearly established that Miss Adams was innocent.

Evangelism Records Climb

Dr. John Wesley White, an associate evangelist with Billy Graham, and known across Canada for his weekly TV programs during the last ten years, reports a record in evangelism was set in 1982. While a drift away from the conventional denominational churches in the western world is generally reported, overflowing attendances and an unprecedented number of decisions for Christ have been registered in Dr. White's crusades across North America.

The Church in Russia

The Slavic Gospel Association reports that the number of churches the Soviet government permits to function legally is restricted to 8,000 Orthodox churches and 5,000 Protestant churches for a population of 266 million people.

Chinese Seminary Grows

Nanjing Union Theological Seminary, China's only Protestant seminary, reopened in 1981 with an enrollment of 52 students from 22 provinces. The seminary also serves 32,000 lay workers by a correspondence course.
