General Information about the Dedicatory Services for the Jimmy Swaggart World Ministry Center to be held May 8, 1983 in Baton Rouge, LA.

Since early 1981, Jimmy Swaggart Ministries has been in a massive building program -- constructing a new world headquarters just off Interstate 10 in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

This impressive complex, called the World Ministry Center, covers an area of approximately 100 acres. It consists of three main buildings: the administrative building, the production building and the Vance Teleproduction Center (still under construction), as well as other auxiliary structures.

Significance of this event:

- 1. No one in parking lot taking down license #s
- No tear gas will be thrown by govt. agents into this gathering to break up our meeting.
- No police will club us with sticks or hose us with water cannon as we come and go.
