

Previous editions of this directory merely listed all included service organizations in alphabetical order with a listing of State departments of veterans affairs appearing at the end of the directory.

This year we have arranged the directory into the following four parts:

Part I: Service organizations which are chartered by Congress and which are recognized or approved by the Administrator of Veterans Affairs for purposes of preparation, presentation and prosecution of claims under laws administered by the Veterans Administration (VA), as provided in section 3402 of title 38, United States Code (U.S.C.) and section 14.628(a) of title 38, Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.).

Part II: Service organizations other than Federally chartered or State organizations which have been certified (or "recognized") by the VA as veterans organizations primarily involved in delivering services connected with either title 38, U.S.C. benefits and programs or other Federal and State programs designed to assist veterans. Certification (or "recognition") of these organizations is contigent upon VA's determination that they provide responsible, qualified representation in the preparation of claims for title 38, U.S.C. benefits. (38 C.F.R. subsection 14.628(c).)

Part III: Service organizations other than Federally chartered or State organizations which have <u>not</u> been certified (or "recognized") by the VA as being <u>primarily involved</u> in delivering services connected with either title 38, U.S.C. benefits or other Federal and State programs designed to assist veterans, but which are included in this directory because they do provide valuable aid and assistance to veterans.

Part IV: State organizations recognized by the VA. (38 C.F.R., subsection 14.628(b).)

Inclusion of organizations in this directory does not constitute, and is in no way related to, VA certification or recognition of said organizations and their representatives for purposes of representation of VA claimants. Please refer to sections 3401 through 3405 of title 38, U.S.C. and sections 14.626 through 14.637 of title 38, C.F.R.

Finally, inclusion of veterans organizations in this directory is at the discretion, and is the sole prerogative, of the Administrator of Veterans Affairs.










