SUBJECT: Interviews for religious broadcasters

About 4,200 religious broadcasters from around the country will be in Washington from January 31 to February 4 for the Annual National Religious Broadcasters Convention. The President has addressed the convention four times and sent a videotape last year. He will be sending a videotape again this year.

Because the religious broadcasters have been such strong supporters of the President and his policies, we would like to provide them with several White House spokespersons who could be interviewed on key issues for 1987. These interviews would be an excellent opportunity to forward the President's agenda, particularly since they will be rebroadcast across the country. They are particularly interested in the budget, SDI and foreign policy, specifically Central America and South Africa.
