- And to all of you in the "Just Say No" dance troupe, I can't tell you how much I enjoyed your performance. It was absolutely wonderful!

- Having been involved in show business myself a long time ago, let me tell you that I see a lot of talent and a very special enthusiasm. And it's that enthusiasm, which comes through not only in your performance, but in your message about drug abuse, that makes this play so effective.

- The message is strong and clear -- that drugs lead only to pain, sorrow, and confusion -- and when you say no to drugs, you're saying yes to a whole lot more.
