  DRUG ABUSE IS COVERED IN YOUR REQUIRED COURSES IN BIOCHEMISTRY
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  UNDERSTAND THE MEDICAL ASPECTS OF DRUG ABUSE. BUT I HOPE YOUR
  COURSES HAVE PREPARED YOU FOR THE EXTENT TO WHICH DRUGS PERVADE

- -- UP UNTIL A COUPLE OF YEARS AGO, MOST OF US, INCLUDING PHYSICIANS, DIDN'T WANT TO BELIEVE THERE WAS A DRUG EPIDEMIC AMONG THE CHILDREN OF THIS SOCIETY. WE MIGHT HAVE BELIEVED THERE WAS DRUG ABUSE AMONG THE CHILDREN OF THE GHETTO OR THE BARRIO, BUT NOT IN PLEASANTVILLE. FORTUNATELY, THIS ATTITUDE OF DENIAL IS CHANGING.
- -- BUT EVEN NOW, AND IN SPITE OF THE TREMENDOUS PUBLICITY,
  YOU'D BE SURPRISED BY THE INNOCENCE OF SOME PHYSICIANS. DR. IAN
  MACDONALD, THE WHITE HOUSE ADVISOR ON DRUG ABUSE, WAS TELLING ME
  THE OTHER DAY OF A CONVERSATION HE'D RECENTLY HAD WITH A WELLKNOWN PEDIATRICIAN. THEY BEGAN DISCUSSING CHILDREN WHO ABUSE
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- -- YET THERE ARE MANY, MANY PARENTS OUT THERE WHO STILL DON'T KNOW WHAT IS HAPPENING TO THEIR CHILDREN. THEY MAY SUSPECT, BUT THEY WON'T CONFRONT THE TRUTH THAT THEIR SON OR DAUGHTER IS ON DRUGS. THEY CONVINCE THEMSELVES IT'S NORMAL ADOLESCENT REBELLION.
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- -- AS YOU KNOW, THE MEDICAL COMMUNITY ITSELF IS NOT IMMUNE FROM THE DANGERS OF DRUGS, SO LET ME ADDRESS FOR A MOMENT THE MATTER OF DRUG USE BY DOCTORS, MEDICAL STUDENTS AND NURSES. A STUDY CONDUCTED BY HARVARD UNIVERSITY FOUND THAT ONE IN TEN OF THE PHYSICIANS AND MED STUDENTS SURVEYED WERE CURRENTLY USING ILLICIT DRUGS. THIS DID NOT INCLUDE ALCOHOL.
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  MY BROTHER IS ALSO A NEUROSURGEON. I UNDERSTAND THE STRESSES IN

  A DOCTOR'S LIFE. YET, AS MY BROTHER RECENTLY SAID TO ME, THE

  STRESS IS SELF-INFLICTED, AND DRUGS ARE NOT THE MEANS TO REDUCE

  IT. YOU CAN'T BUY PEACE WITH A PILL OR A POWDER.
- -- THE PART OF THE HARVARD STUDY THAT WOULD HAVE ABSOLUTELY APPALLED MY FATHER WAS THIS SENTENCE: "DESPITE ITS RECENT INCREASE, RECREATIONAL DRUG USE BY PHYSICIANS AND MEDICAL STUDENTS SIMPLY REFLECTS CURRENT TRENDS IN RECREATIONAL DRUG USE THROUGHOUT AMERICAN SOCIETY..."
- -- WELL, QUITE FRANKLY, THAT'S NOT GOOD ENOUGH. DOCTORS SHOULD DO MORE THAN SIMPLY REFLECT CURRENT TRENDS IN DRUG USE. YOU HAVE A HIGHER OBLIGATION BECAUSE YOU ARE THE BEST AND THE BRIGHTEST. YOU ARE HELD MORE ACCOUNTABLE BECAUSE OF THE PROFESSION YOU'VE CHOSEN. TO PUT IT PLAINLY, DOCTORS SHOULD KNOW BETTER, AND THEIR PATIENTS DESERVE BETTER.
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  STUDY FOUND, MEDICAL EDUCATION THAT SIMPLY EMPHASIZES THE BIOLOGY

  OF ADDICTION ISN'T SUFFICIENT TO PREVENT PHYSICIAN DRUG ABUSE.
- -- NOR, BY THE WAY, IS IT SUFFICIENT TO DEAL WITH THE EMOTIONAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL NEEDS OF DRUG ABUSERS OR THEIR FAMILIES.

- -- BUT I HAVEN'T COME THIS AFTERNOON SIMPLY TO POINT OUT PROBLEMS. I'VE ALSO COME WITH A CURE FOR DRUG ABUSE. IT'S A PREVENTATIVE THAT WORKS FOR ANY AGE, ANY SEX, ANY RACE, AND AGAINST ANY DRUG. IT'S ALSO AN ANTIDOTE FOR THOSE STRUGGLING TO OVERCOME DRUGS. THE REMEDY IS SELF-ESTEEM.
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  THE CONSEQUENCES OF THAT VOID ARE GREATER TODAY THAN EVER BEFORE IN HISTORY. OTHER ERAS HAVE HAD THEIR OWN MEANS OF ESCAPE, LIKE ALCOHOL. THE DANGER TODAY IS THAT, WITH SOMETHING LIKE CRACK, ADDICTION CAN BE VERY RAPID -- ALMOST INSTANTANEOUS. THE STAKES FOR EXPERIMENTATION AND SEARCHING FOR ONESELF HAVE BEEN GREATLY INCREASED.
- -- SHOULDN'T DOCTORS, WHO ARE TRAINED IN PREVENTING
  ILLNESS, ALSO HAVE A MAJOR RESPONSIBILITY IN PREVENTING DRUG
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SEPARATE NEEDS FROM WANTS, AND UNDERSTAND THERE ARE LOGICAL CONSEQUENCES TO ONE'S ACTIONS.

- TEACHERS, AND I THINK THAT IS WHAT YOU MUST BE. I KNOW THE INSURANCE COMPANIES WON'T PAY YOU FOR DOING THIS. I KNOW YOU WON'T BE REIMBURSED FOR YOUR TROUBLES. BUT YOU ARE MORE THAN THAT TERRIBLE PHRASE -- HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS -- WOULD IMPLY. YOU ARE DOCTORS. YOUR PATIENTS ARE MORE THAN CONSUMERS. THEY ARE THE SICK AND THE HURT.
- -- I'M NOT TRYING TO REVIVE THE PAST WHEN I SAY THE DOCTOR/PATIENT RELATIONSHIP IS AS RELEVANT TODAY AS IT WAS 30 YEARS AGO. THE IRONIC THING IS THAT THE MORE NEW MEDICINES AND TECHNOLOGIES WE HAVE, THE MORE WE NEED THE HUMAN BOND BETWEEN DOCTOR AND PATIENT. LONG BEFORE WE HAD MIRACLE DRUGS AND INSURANCE CLAIM FORMS, WE HAD THE DOCTOR SITTING AT A PATIENT'S BEDSIDE, GIVING COMFORT AND STRENGTH AND SHOWING COMPASSION.
- TELL ME. AT THE TURN OF THE CENTURY, THERE WAS A MEDICAL MISSIONARY IN INDIA BY THE NAME OF SHAW. - -- ALTHOUGH THIS EXAMPLE ISN'T DRUG RELATED, A DOCTOR WAS TELLING ME JUST THE OTHER DAY ABOUT A 15 YEAR OLD BOY WHO CAME TO HIM WITH A VARIETY OF SYMPTOMS OVER A PERIOD OF TIME. THE DOCTOR SIMPLY COULDN'T FIGURE OUT WHAT WAS WRONG WITH THE BOY, UNTIL HE LEARNED THAT THE GRANDMOTHER HAD ALZHEIMERS, AND IT WAS TEARING THE FAMILY APART.
- DRUGS HAVE THE SAME RIPPLE EFFECT. THE DRUG ABUSER ABUSES NOT ONLY HIMSELF, BUT HIS FAMILY. HE HATES; HE LIES;

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HE STEALS; HE CAN BE VIOLENT OR WITHDRAWN; HE LOVES NOTHING BUT THE CHEMICAL THAT GIVES HIM HIS HIGH OR LESSENS HIS PAIN.

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THE HEAD MANAGES OF THE MANAGER OF STREET STUDENTS, 27 PERCENT CLASSIFIED THEMSELVES AS USERS OF MARIJUANA AND NEARLY 11 PERCENT CLASSIFIED THEMSELVES AS USERS OF COCAINE.



I BELIEVE DOCTORS, ESPECIALLY PEDIATRICIANS, SHOULD OFFER GUIDANCE TO PARENTS ON BUILDING A CHILD'S SELF-IMAGE. THEY SHOULD LET PARENTS KNOW HOW IMPORTANT IT IS TO BOND THE CHILD TO FAMILY AND SOCIETY. THEY SHOULD TELL PARENTS HOW ESSENTIAL IT IS THAT A CHILD LEARN TO DEFER GRATIFICATION, SEPARATE NEEDS FROM WANTS, AND UNDERSTAND THERE ARE LOGICAL CONSEQUENCES TO ONE'S ACTIONS.
