Attached is a proposed draft summary schedule.

Event Concept

On Monday, February 1, 1988, The President and Mrs. Reagan will join up to 4,000 members of the National Religious Broadcasters Association (NRB) at their annual convention. Composed of religious activists from around the world, the NRB comprises an important element in the President's constituency.

This year the NRB will consider the "Accountability to God and Man - 45 Years of Service and Integrity" as their convention theme. As an extension of this theme, the association will be announcing its new ethics and financial accountability board.

Upon arrival, The President and Mrs. Reagan will greet approximately 10 members of the Executive Committee and their spouses prior to proceeding into the Grand Ballroom.

The NRB will honor Mrs. Reagan with an award based on her activities with the Foster Grandparent program. The President will follow shortly thereafter with remarks to the delegation. Prior to departure, the President and Mrs. Reagan will be asked to join Mr. Lloyd Ogilvie at the podium for a closing prayer.

A similar memorandum will be forwarded to Rhett Dawson for submission to the President unless otherwise instructed.
