- -- THANK YOU. FIRST, LET ME CONGRATULATE ALL THE HONORED PRINCIPALS, COMMUNITY LEADERS, PARENTS AND STUDENTS WHO ARE HERE WITH US TODAY. -- I WANT TO MENTION THE WORK OF THE PRINCIPALS ACROSS THE COUNTRY, BECAUSE I KNOW THAT IT IS OFTEN DIFFICULT FOR THEM TO TAKE A FIRM, STRICT STAND AGAINST DRUGS. STRANGELY ENOUGH, THERE ARE FREQUENTLY PRESSURES WORKING AGAINST FIRMNESS, AND THE PRINCIPALS NEED THE SUPPORT OF COMMUNITY LEADERS AND PARENTS TO BACK THEM IN THEIR STAND. WE HAVE SUCH DEDICATED AND FIRM PRINCIPALS AND

PARENTS AND COMMUNITY LEADERS WITH US TODAY.

THAT IT IS YOU WHO WILL EVENTUALLY SOLVE THE DRUG CRISIS IN THIS COUNTRY. WE COULD HAVE PARENTS AND TEACHERS FOLLOWING CHILDREN'S EVERY MOVE. WE COULD HAVE DRUG AGENTS ON EVERY CORNER, TREATMENT CENTERS ON VERY BLOCK, JAILS IN EVERY NEIGHBORHOOD, AND STILL THERE WOULD BE THE DEMAND FOR DRUGS.
