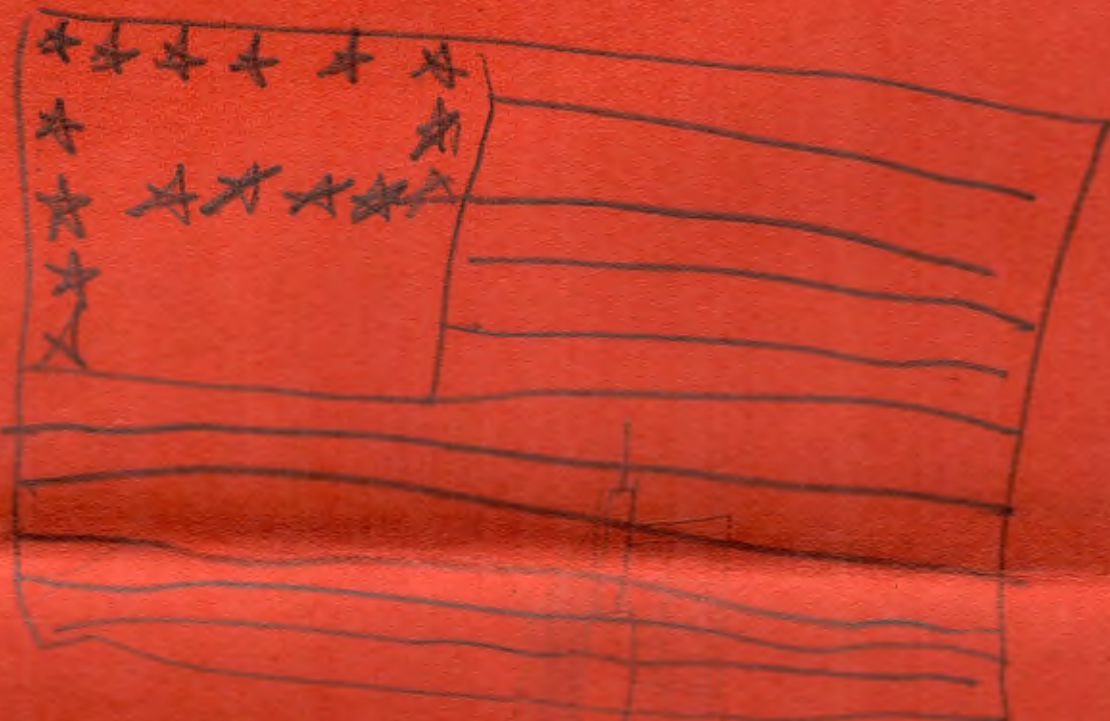

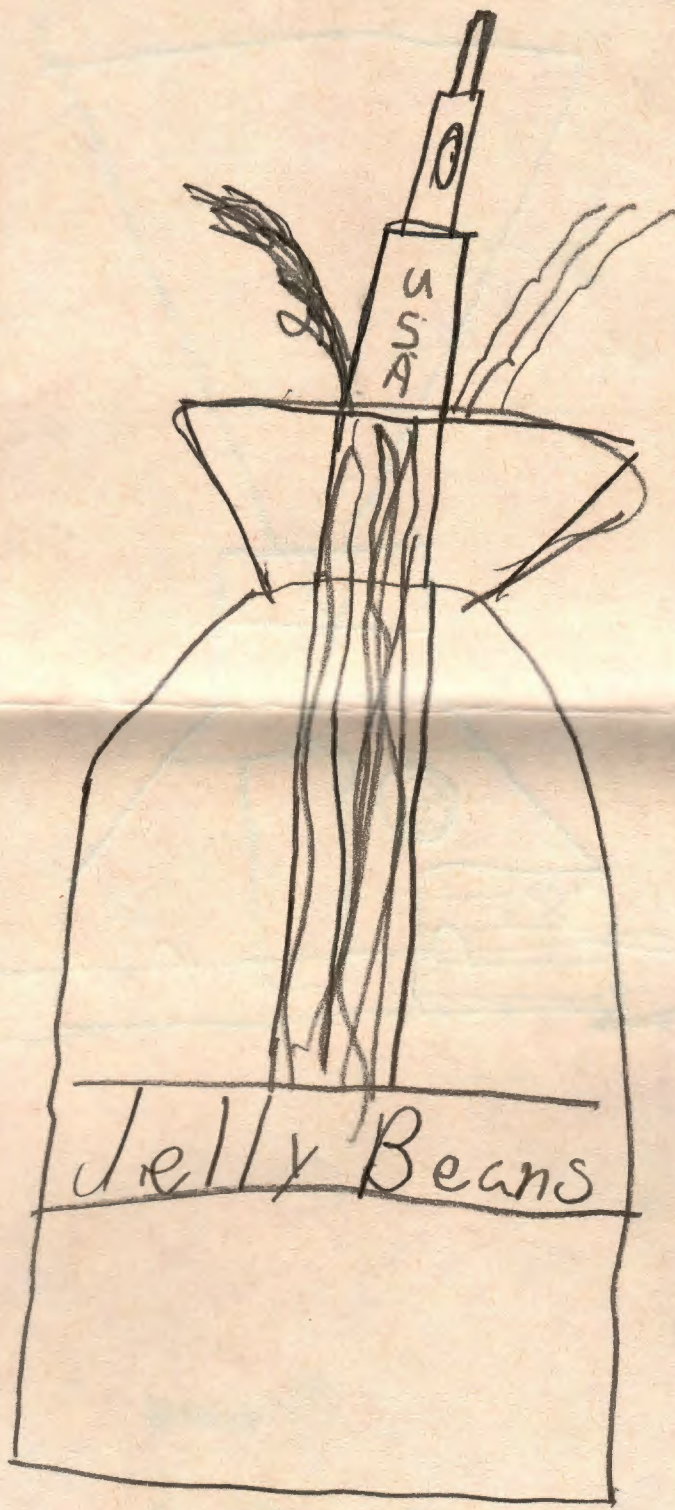

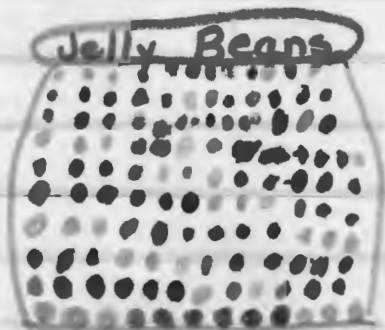
April 2, 1982

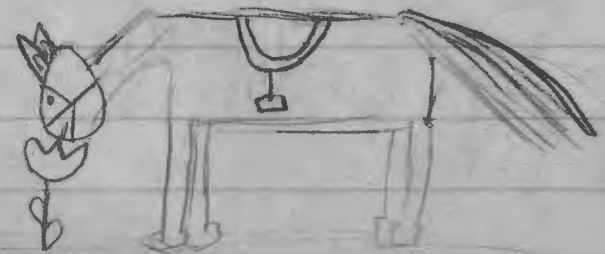
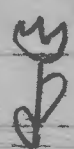
