Dear Judge Clark:

I have received correspondence from Mr. Michael H. Posner, Executive Director of the Lawyers Committee for International Human Rights in New York, who indicates that on January 17, 1983, the Lawyers Committee requested information collected by the National Security Council on the case of the churchwomen who were killed in El Salvador in December, 1980. The Lawyers Committee had asked that the estimated \$250 fee for processing information be waived, but they were told on February 7, 1983, that the waiver request had been denied because the request was not "considered as primarily benefiting the general public."

Surely the public attention that has been given to this case and the very widespread concern it has raised warrants a waiving of this fee in order that families of the four churchwomen may be assured that all information that might be pertinent to the prosecution of the case has been made available. As you know, the seemingly tedious movement of events in this case is one of the issues that makes our discussion of political developments in El Salvador very difficult. Surely a decision to waive a small fee for processing information would be a positive sign from the Administration of its deep concern that this case be resolved as expeditiously as possible.

I hope that you might suggest to the Freedom of Information Office that the decision to waive the fee for processing information relevant to the case of the murder of the four American churchwomen would certainly be a decision "benefiting the general public."

I look forward to hearing from you on this issue.



The Chief of the FBI FOI/PA Section has referred to you one White House document found in FBI files that is responsive to the above referenced Freedom of Information request, and has requested your views regarding the release of such document to the requestor.

The document is a memorandum from David Niles, Administrative Assistant to President Truman, to J. Edgar Hoover enclosing a letter he has received from an individual who apparently was concerned about the protection of President Truman. Niles notes in his referral memorandum to Hoover that the correspondent quotes from Gerald K. Smith's magazine "The Cross and Flag"; Niles then states his opinion that Smith's attacks on him are libelous. These documents are responsive to the Jeansonne FOIA request because that request is for "each document or other record relating directly or indirectly to the involvement of Gerald L.K. Smith in "The Cross and the Flag", 1942-1976.

None of the exemptions from disclosure under 5 U.S.C. § 552(b) are applicable to the documents in question. The "inter-agency memorandum" exemption, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5), would not protect this document because it does not appear to be a deliberative or pre-decisional memoranda, and it does not appear to be an attorney-client document. Similarly, standing alone, the document does not appear to fall within the law enforcement investigatory records exemption of 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7). Accordingly, I believe we must allow this document to be released in response to the above referenced request.

Attached for your review and signature is a memorandum to the Chief advising that we have reviewed the document referred to us and have no legal objections to its release to the requestor.

WE SUGGEST MR. DEAVER COVER THE FOLLOWING SUBJECTS DURING THE MEETING:

(A) THE PRESIDENT'S CAREER AND PERSONALITY: POPE WILL WANT TO DEVELOP A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THE PRESIDENT. WE SUGGEST DEAVER BRING WITH HIM A BRIEF BIOGRAPHY OF THE PRESIDENT TO GIVE TO SILVESTRINI AND DESCRIBE THE PRESIDENT'S PERSONALITY TO SILVESTRINI.

- (B) ADVISE SILVESTRINI THAT DURING HIS AUDIENCE WITH THE POPE THE PRESIDENT MAY INVITE HIM TO VISIT THE WESTERN PART OF THE U.S.

MR. DEAVER SHOULD BE PREPARED TO ADVISE SILVESTRINI OF THE APPROXIMATE SIZE AND PROBABLE COMPOSITION OF THE PRESIDENTIAL DELEGATION.

MR. DEAVER COULD ALSO RAISE WITH SILVESTRINI THE DESIRABILITY OF A CONCURRENT MEETING BETWEEN SECRETARY HAIG AND CARDINAL CASAROLI AND DESCRIBE WHO WOULD BE INCLUDED IN HAIG'S GROUP.

FINALLY WE SUGGEST DEAVER REVIEW WITH (F) SILVESTRINI THE PROBABLE SCHEDULE OF THE PRESIDENT IN ROME. SILVESTRINI WILL BE PARTICULARLY INTERESTED IN KNOWING OF THE PRESIDENT'S PLANS AFTER HE DEPARTS THE QUIRINALE AND AFTER HE LEAVES VATICAN CITY. WILSON
