The President today announced his intention to nominate Samuel A. Alito, of New Jersey, to be the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey for the term of four years. He would succeed W. Hunt Dumont.

Mr. Alito has served as a Law Clerk for the Honorable Leonard I. Garth, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit from 1976 to 1977; Assistant United States Attorney, District of New Jersey, from 1977 to 1981; as an Assistant to the Solicitor General, Department of Justice, 1981-1985; and as Deputy Assistant Attorney General, Office of Legal Counsel, Department of Justice, 1985-1987. Since March 18, 1987, Mr. Alito has served as the Interim United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey.

Mr. Alito graduated from Princeton University (A.B., 1972) and Yale Law School (J.D., 1975). He served in the United States Army Reserves, 1972-1980. Mr. Alito was born April 1, 1950 in Trenton, New Jersey. He is married, has one child and resides in Bethesda, Maryland.
