

DATE June 24, 1981

At the meeting yesterday, Lyn, Howard Phillips mentioned the imminence of a report from the Assistant Attorney General of the Office of Legal Counsel which would position the Administration against any limitation on the Supreme Court's appellate jurisdiction.

At the time, several of us in the meeting spoke urgently about the need to prevent the Administration taking such a position. Such action would be an affront to the members of Congress and the President's supporters who have proposed such a remedy for judicial activism in areas of prayer, busing, right to life, drafting women -- to name a few.

Care should be taken that the Administration not get on the wrong side of these issues, and least of all on the wrong side of its friends on those issues.

We are attaching a copy of the brand-new data from the Sindlinger Polls on questions of public evaluations of the judicial branch of government. I have never seen such high figures as these:

"Would you favor congressional efforts to withdraw federal court jurisdiction over cases involving issues such as busing?" Yes -- 81.3% No -- 14.6%

Not only would the Administration get on the wrong side of its friends by taking the wrong position of jurisdictional limitation -- it would also be getting on the wrong side of 81% of the American public. And right now the Administration cannot afford that.

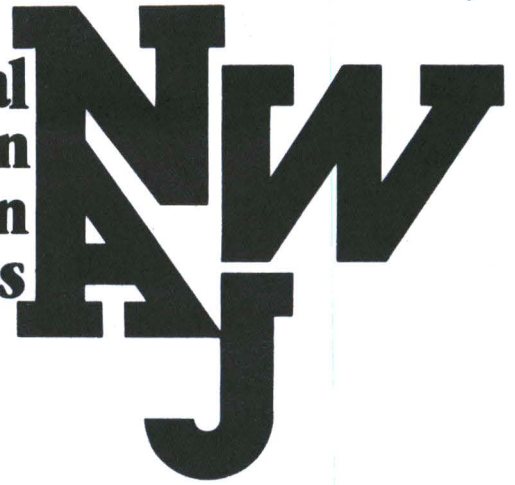
