The membership of the National Association of Women Judges, which includes over half of all the women judges in the United States, salutes your appointment of the first female to the highest court in the land. By virtue of this perspicacious act, you have guaranteed yourself a very special place in the history of these United States.


For years women have been watching and waiting for the day when a president would select a highly qualified woman to take a rightful seat on the Supreme Court. Even though there have been such women available for at least the last decade, we have been disheartened in this regard with each successive appointment. In our pluralistic society wherein women constitute 51% of the population, it is only fair and just that a qualified female be involved in the precedent-setting high court decisional processes.

So many women judges have been performing exceptionally well, yet with little recognition and acceptance, sometimes being virtually isolated and otherwise functioning under very trying circumstances. Your announcement happily has focused attention on us and created interest in us as individuals and as a group. We have thus become the beneficiaries of immediate increased stature and greater credibility.

Telegrams of endorsement have been sent to Senate Judiciary Chairman Strom Thurmond, Senate Majority Leader Howard Baker and Senator Jesse Helms. In addition, news releases have been distributed to all of the wire services and a CBS television interview was taped in Lexington, Kentucky on July 12 for distribution to the networks. Further, letters have been sent to each member of the United States Senate regarding the endorsement.
