In addition to \$2.5 million in Federal funds, the services of the FBI and the Departments of Justice, Education and Health and Human Services have been employed toward this end. I am enclosing two statements by the President which detail these actions.

President Reagan appreciates your interest and your prayers. Please be assured that this Administration will continue to do everything possible to help the citizens of Atlanta restore peace and safety to their city.

As you know, the Attorney General considers violent crime to be a matter of great national concern, and he has created the Task Force on Violent Crime to advise him as to what the Federal government's role should be in combating this problem.

In this regard, the Attorney General has directed the Task Force to report its recommendations to him expeditiously and in two phases. The first phase will focus on what the federal government can do within the present statutory and funding framework. The second phase will focus on recommendations for necessary and appropriate changes in federal laws, funding levels and allocation of resources which would increase the coordinated federal-state-local fight against violent crime.

I certainly would be pleased to receive any further information or suggestions you care to submit. It would greatly assist the Task Force if you would take the time to send us your thoughts and recommendations in writing. Please be assured that your comments will be considered by the Attorney General's Task Force on Violent Crime.



SUBJECT: Contact with Ed Meese's Office Concerning E.O. 12036

Yesterday evening I received a "heads up" from the CIA General Counsel's Office that the LA Times had contacted CIA concerning Ed Meese's remarks yesterday before a group of District Attorneys. Apparently, Ed Meese made a statement that the policies contained in E.O. 12036 prevented the CIA from conducting surveillance of Americans abroad who are engaged in narcotics trafficking. The LA Times wanted to know if this was true. CIA cited the relevant sections of the E.O. and referred them to the White House Press Office.

The Meese statement is incorrect with regard to physical surveillance but generally correct with regard to electronic surveillance and other intrusive techniques. At Phyllis Kaminsky's request I passed this information to Mitch Stanley in Ed Meese's office who had already been in contact with the White House Press Office. *ok*

This morning Frank Ursomarso called and asked for a copy of E.O. 12036. I also gave him background on this issue and for his information stressed that this incident was a perfect example of what was wrong with the Executive Order--namely the aura of restrictiveness which surrounds it. Even people in the field remain confused as to what is or is not permitted. We will try to obtain a copy of the actual remarks which were taped.

The President has asked us to respond to your letter concerning the investigation into the deaths of the murdered and missing children in Atlanta and the prayer vigil sponsored by your church. We apologize for the delay in this response, and we trust that the vigil was a success.

We wish to advise you that since August, 1980 the FBI has been providing Atlanta investigators with a variety of technical and expert assistance to ensure that the federal government was fully supportive of their efforts to solve these crimes. On November 6, 1980, the Department of Justice initiated a preliminary investigation by the FBI to determine whether the children now missing in Atlanta are being held in violation of the federal kidnapping law. The Department has recently extended to Atlanta the assistance of the Community Relations Service, the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, and the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention. In addition, the Federal government has allocated \$1.5 million dollars in funds which will be provided directly to the city of Atlanta to assist in defraying the costs of the Task Force investigation.

Vice President Bush is personally overseeing the Federal government's response to the tragic situation in Atlanta, in order to hasten the day when those responsible for the deaths and disappearances are apprehended and prosecuted.
