Donald Clarey started in the Office of Cabinet Affairs in July 1983 as a consultant. In August 1983 he converted to a detailee from the Department of Commerce and was given the title of Associate Director. In October, 1985 he was promoted to Special Assistant to the President and Deputy Director of Cabinet Affairs under new Cabinet Secretary Al Kingon. Clarey left the White House for an appointment as Deputy Administrator at the Small Business Administration in May 1987. Clarey took over White House coordination for this group in early 1984.
