Biography

Frank Ursomarso is an American political strategist and an automotive industry executive with Delaware car dealerships.

Ursomarso was born on September 19, 1942 in Delaware. Ursomarso earned a B.A. degree from Gettysburg College in 1964, and a J.D. degree from UCLA in 1967.

During Ursomarso's service in the U.S. Army as a military police officer, he was a member of the task force on domestic disturbances. On October 21, 1967, his unit, the 503d Military Police Battalion, was deployed to the Pentagon for the "March on the Pentagon," a Vietnam War protest. He served one year in Vietnam and was awarded the Bronze Star Medal.

Frank's political career began in 1973, working with newly installed President Gerald R. Ford as a staff assistant. He remained in the Ford Administration until 1976. During this time, his most memorable moment was walking beside President Ford in Sacramento California, when a shooting attempt was made on President Ford. His ties to the Ford Administration remain strong, and he is a member of the Gerald R. Ford Presidential Foundation.

Ursomarso has also had an association with communications and broadcasting. He has served as a member of the Pennsylvania Public Television Network. With this background, Ursomarso served as the television production coordinator for the 1976 and 1980 presidential debates.

During the Reagan Administration, Ursomarso was appointed as Deputy Assistant to the President and Director of Communications effective February 23, 1981. He reported to David Gergen, who was Deputy to the Chief of Staff at the time. Following the injury to Press Secretary James Brady in the assassination attempt on President Reagan, communications responsibilities were revamped and revised. David Gergen was named Assistant to the President for Communications and Director of the Office of Communications. This office then became an umbrella office covering the White House Press Office, Office of Communications (Public Affairs) and Speechwriting. Ursomarso eventually resigned in September, 1981.

Ursomarso has other public service experience. He served on the Pennsylvania Securities Commission, the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission, and was Chairman of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission.

Currently Ursomarso is Chairman of Union Park Automotive Group, a franchised automotive dealership for BMW, Volvo, Honda, Buick GMC and Jaguar brands. It has been in business and family-owned for three generations.

Ursomarso is a member of the Delaware Automobile and Truck Dealers Association. He also served on the Industry Relations and Communications Committees during his tenure on the Board of Directors at the National Automobile Dealers Association (NADA).

Ursomarso is married to the former Catherine Sanders and lives in Wilmington, Delaware. He has three sons and three grandchildren.

Scope and Content Note

Originally the Library did not have an identified collection for Frank Ursomarso. During the arrangement and determination of provenance for the Office of Communications, references to Ursomarso and his work product were referred to by other Communications staff members. The Library subsequently discovered the Ursomarso material had been filed with the White House Office of Records Management collection for Michael Baroody in the Office of Public Affairs. Baroody was Ursomarso's assistant in the Office of Communications and eventually became the Director of the Office of Public Affairs.
