Biography

Donald Arthur Mahley was an American military officer and diplomat.

Donald Mahley was born on July 16, 1942 in Peru, Indiana. Mahley is a graduate of Purdue University (1964) majoring in philosophy. He then attended the Graduate School of Public and International Affairs at the University of Pittsburgh (1971) for his master's degree. His military education includes Air Defense, Nuclear Weapons, Command and General Staff College, and the National War College.

Mahley's military career included service in South Viet Nam, Turkey and Belgium and he successfully held three command positions during his active military career. He also served as an Assistant Professor of Social Sciences at the United States Military Academy and an Associate Professor of Military Strategy at the National War College. Mahley retired as a United States Army officer, Ordnance, rank of Colonel, in 1992.

Mahley served four years in the U.S. Mission to NATO, as Deputy Director of the Defense Plans Division for the U.S. Ambassador to NATO. Mahley was then detailed to the White House National Security Council staff. Starting with the Reagan Administration in 1984 he remained there through 1990, serving the first two years of the George H.W. Bush Administration. Mahley served on the NSC Defense Policy and Arms Control staff and was eventually made the Director of this office.

While still in military service, Mahley switched his focus to negotiation and diplomacy and began a long second career with the Department of State. His first position was from 1990-1992 as Associate Assistant Director of the Multilateral Affairs Bureau and he led U.S. efforts to conclude the Chemical Weapons Convention. He was the official United States Representative to the "Organisation for the Control of Chemical Weapons." Mahley has stated that he feels this was probably one of his largest accomplishments in a long public service career. Mahley states, "My answer today (his greatest accomplishment) is completing the Chemical Weapons Convention in 1992, realizing for perhaps the first time during my government career that without my personal efforts and input, despite the fact that others by the hundreds around the world contributed much more of the content of the final document, there would not have been such a Convention, and chemical weapons would still be an ordinary part of military inventories."

From 1993 until 1999, Ambassador Mahley served as Deputy Assistant Director and Acting Assistant Director of the Multilateral Affairs Bureau of the Arms Control and Disarmament Agency (ACDA). Concurrently from 1993 to 2002 Ambassador Mahley headed the United States Delegation to Biological Weapons Convention activities and was the Managing Director of the United States National Authority for implementation of the Chemical Weapons Convention and the United States Representative to the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons.

Ambassador Mahley's final position at the State Department was as Deputy Assistant Secretary for Threat Reduction, Export Controls, and Negotiations, 2003-2008. As such, he had the responsibility for chemical and biological weapons threat reduction, missile threat reduction, conventional weapons threat reduction, and export controls. Part of his responsibilities was guaranteeing Libya's destruction of Weapons of Mass Destruction. Ambassador Mahley recalls this time, "when I stepped off the plane in Tripoli, Libya, in January 2004 to be the personal representative of the President in negotiating with Mohammar Qaddafi about how he [Qaddafi] was going to carry out the promise he had just made to destroy all his programs for Weapons of Mass Destruction. I kept thinking about how United States citizens were forbidden to travel to Libya, how in an earlier job I had recommended approval of U.S. aircraft bombing Libya in an effort to kill the same Qaddafi, and how there were no ways I could call somebody back in the U.S. for real-time advice on whether the proposal I was about to make really made sense. That was really a time when I thought to myself, 'How did an Indiana farm boy ever get here?'"

Ambassador Mahley retired in 2008. In his retirement, Ambassador Mahley served on the State Department's Bureau of International Security and Nonproliferation as the Special Negotiator for Nonproliferation on an as needed basis, with responsibilities for the Arms Trade Treaty Open Ended Group. He served from June 2011 until his death in March 2014. He was also a member of the United Nations Secretary General's Disarmament Advisory Board.

Donald Mahley died from cancer at his home in Vienna, Virginia on March 1, 2014.
